


Report to the Metropolitan Council of Nashville, Tennessee Davidson County

Pursuant to BL2008-248 please find below the response from the District Attorney General:

Actions taken to reduce paper and postage consumption:

While the Office of the District Attorney General makes every effort to minimize costs for postage, the annual budget appropriations for postage expenses have not been sufficient to cover the annual expenses related to case volumes until FY2011 when the allocation was \$18,200.00. Postal expenses are directly related to case arrests by the Metropolitan Police Department and other law enforcement agencies, and cannot be impacted alone by this office. In addition this office has faced increased postal expense charges from the Federal Postal Service. Starting in FY2015 Postal Services became a General Fund department.



Paper:

While the Office of the District Attorney General makes every effort to minimize costs for paper purchases, the bulk of paper usage is related to case preparation, prosecutions, and correspondence. These expenses are non-discretionary and are directly related to case volumes.
