a. Entrance wound on anterior neck

b. Injuries to strap muscles of the neck, right carotid artery, right jugular vein, trachea, right lung, right ribs 3 and 4

c. Exit wound on right upper back

d. Polymer bullet fragment recovered from right chest cavity

e. Trajectory: Front to back, left to right, downward

II. Multiple superficial incised wounds of upper extremities consistent with "cutting"

III. Venous stasis dermatitis of lower extremities

IV. Toxicology positive for fentanyl, methamphetamine, and amphetamine

The autopsy was performed at the Center for Forensic Medicine. The purpose of this report is to provide a certified opinion to the County Medical Examiner and District Attorney General. The facts and findings to support these conclusions are filed with the Tennessee Department of Health. The autopsy was performed in the presence of Christopher Geffre, M.D.

#### **EVIDENCE OF INJURY:**

Indeterminate range gunshot wound of the neck: Located on the anterior neck 13 inches from the top the head and 1/2 inch right of the anterior midline is a 1/4 inch diameter gunshot entrance wound. A 1/8 inch wide red-brown marginal abrasion surrounds the wound. No gunpowder stippling, soot, or muzzle abrasion surrounds the wound. The bullet perforated the soft tissues of

the neck causing injuries to the strap muscles, right carotid artery, right jugular vein, and trachea. The bullet entered the right thoracic cavity superior to right rib 1 and perforated the upper lobe of the right lung. The bullet fractured right ribs 3 and 4 at the costovertebral margin with associated cortical fracture of the lateral aspect of vertebra T3. 1290 mL of liquid and clotted blood is present in the right thoracic cavity. A red polymer bullet fragment is recovered from the blood within the right thoracic cavity. Small bone fragments are present within the blood in the right thoracic cavity. Located on the right upper back 14 inches from the top the head and 3 inches right of the posterior midline is a gunshot exit wound. With the body in standard anatomic position the trajectory is front to back, left to right, and downward.

#### **EXTERNAL EXAMINATION**

Rigor: Present in the jaw, neck, and extremities

Therapy: An endotracheal tube extends from the mouth. There is an intravenous line in the left

antecubital fossa.

General: The body is well-developed. The corneas are slightly cloudy. The sclerae are tan-white and free of hemorrhage and petechiae. The conjunctivae are pale and free of hemorrhage and petechiae. The external auditory canals and nares are free of debris and lesions. The lips and mouth are uninjured and the frenula are intact. The oral cavity is edentulous. The chest is normally formed, symmetrical, and without palpable masses. The abdomen is unremarkable. The external genitalia are those of a normal adult male phenotype and are uninjured. The fingernails are intact with no fresh chips or tears. The upper extremities are normally formed and symmetrical with no clubbing or edema. There are multiple superficial incised wounds on the upper extremities and hands consistent with "cutting". The lower extremities are normally formed and symmetrical with no edema. There are two 1 inch pink red abrasions on the left knee. The skin of the lower extremities distal to the knees is hyperpigmented, dry, scaly, and with scattered red-brown abrasions consistent with venous stasis dermatitis. The toenails are thick and yellow-tan. The back is straight and symmetric. The anus is unremarkable.

**X-rays:** Injuries as described in evidence of injury. A small group of minute radiodense foreign objects are present in the chest. These objects are consistent with minute unrecoverable fragments of bone and/or bullet.

#### INTERNAL EXAMINATION

**GENERAL:** The body cavities have no adhesions. All body organs are in their normal anatomical positions.

PLEURA: Injuries as described in evidence of injury.

**PERITONEUM:** Unremarkable

PERICARDIUM: Unremarkable

**NECK ORGANS:** The tongue has no ulcers or contusions. The nasopharyngeal airways contain blood. The hyoid bone is intact. The thyroid parenchyma is uniform, firm, and red-brown with no focal lesions.

**HEART:** 350 g. The epicardial surface is glistening and smooth. The vena cavae and pulmonary arteries are without thrombus or embolus. The coronary arteries arise normally in the proper sinuses and follow the usual courses. There is no significant atherosclerotic stenosis of the coronary arteries. The chambers and valves exhibit the usual positional relationships and structure. The valves show no evidence of vegetation or thickening. The tricuspid, pulmonic, mitral, and aortic valve circumferences are 14 cm, 8 cm, 11 cm, and 8 cm, respectively. The endocardium is thin and glistening. The atrial and ventricular septa are intact. The papillary muscles and chordae are unremarkable. The myocardium is red-brown and shows no areas of fibrosis, hyperemia or mottling. The right, left, and septal ventricular walls are 0.2 cm, 1 cm, and 1 cm thick, respectively.

AORTA: Unremarkable. The aortic arch has the typical 3 vessel distribution pattern.

**LUNGS:** Right 300 g., Left 490 g. Injuries as described in evidence of injury. The pleural surfaces are glistening and smooth. The parenchyma is red-purple. The upper airway and bronchi contain blood. The pulmonary vasculature is free of thrombi.

**LIVER:** 1700 g. The liver has a smooth capsule that covers unremarkable tan-purple parenchyma with no focal lesions.

GALLBLADDER: Unremarkable gallbladder wall. No calculi present.

**SPLEEN:** 190 g. The spleen has a smooth, intact capsule covering red-purple, firm parenchyma with no focal lesions.

PANCREAS: The pancreas is unremarkable with pink-tan parenchyma and lobular architecture.

**ADRENALS:** The left adrenal gland is unremarkable with yellow tan cortex and grey medulla. Within the cortex of the right adrenal gland is a 2 cm well-circumscribed yellow-tan nodule consistent with adenoma.

**GI TRACT:** The esophagus has gray-white smooth mucosa with normal wall thickness. The stomach contains 40 mL of tan fluid. The stomach has normal rugal folds and unremarkable muscular wall. The pylorus is unremarkable. The small intestine, colon and appendix are unremarkable.

**KIDNEYS:** Right 160 g., Left 140 g. The renal capsules are smooth, thin, semi-transparent, and cover smooth, red-brown cortical surfaces. Serial sections of the kidneys show cortices of normal thickness, slightly congested, and with well delineated corticomedullary junctions. The calyces, pelves, and ureters are free of calculi and are not dilated.

**URINARY BLADDER:** Unremarkable bladder wall and mucosa. Contains greater than 60 mL of pale yellow urine.

**GENITALIA:** The testes and prostate show no injuries and are unremarkable.

BRAIN AND MENINGES: 1540 g. The scalp has no hematomas. The calvarium and skull base have no fractures. The dura mater and falx cerebri are intact. The leptomeninges are thin and delicate. There is no evidence of epidural, subdural, or subarachnoid hemorrhage. The cerebral hemispheres are symmetrical. The gyri and sulci show no evidence of shrinkage or widening respectively. The vessels at the base of the brain are intact with no evidence of aneurysms or significant atherosclerosis. Serial sections of the brain show no evidence of intraparenchymal hemorrhage. The gray-white matter border is distinct. The deep white matter has no softening or masses. The deep gray matter including caudate, putamen, globus pallidus and thalamus are unremarkable. The hippocampal formations and mammillary bodies are unremarkable. The ventricular system is not dilated or compressed. Serial sections of the cerebellum show unremarkable cerebellar folia, deep white matter, and dentate nucleus. Sectioning of the brainstem shows appropriately pigmented for age substantia nigra, and unremarkable medulla and pontine white matter.

BONY SKELETON: Injuries as described in evidence of injury.

#### **SUMMARY AND INTERPRETATION**

The decedent was a 48-year-old phenotypic male who was reportedly shot while involved in an altercation with law enforcement.

Autopsy showed a well-developed body with male phenotype. There was an indeterminate range gunshot wound of the neck with injuries to the strap muscles of the neck, right carotid artery, right jugular vein, trachea, right lung, and right ribs 3 and 4. A polymer bullet fragment was recovered from the right chest cavity. Multiple superficial incised wounds were present on the upper extremities consistent with "cutting".


Toxicological studies performed on postmortem femoral blood detected fentanyl, methamphetamine, and amphetamine.

Death was caused by gunshot wound of the neck. Reports of the death investigation and autopsy findings indicate the manner of death to be homicide.

Examination of the specimen(s) submitted did not reveal any reportable findings by procedure(s) outlined in the accompanying Analysis Summary, other than those listed above. Interpretation of reported findings should be based on the totality of available case information. Reference information is not case-specific but is provided as a general guide.

#### Reference Comments:

Amphetamine - Femoral Blood:

Amphetamine (Adderall, Dexedrine) is a central nervous system stimulant. Amphetamine is also a metabolite of methamphetamine, benzphetamine and selegiline. It is used therapeutically in the treatment of narcolepsy and obesity and also in the treatment of attention-deficit hyperactivity disorder (ADHD). Amphetamine has a high potential for abuse. At low doses, amphetamine causes mild stimulation, offset of fatigue, and increase in alertness. It also causes changes in attitude, judgment and impulsivity. At higher doses, amphetamine causes euphoria, excitation, agitation, hypervigilance, rapid speech, dilated pupils which react slowly to light and increased motor restlessness. Pulse and blood pressure may be elevated. Withdrawal from amphetamine following abuse can result in extreme fatigue and uncontrollable sleepiness, agitation, and depression. In the treatment of narcolepsy, amphetamine is administered in daily divided doses of 5 to 60 mg. In abuse doses of several grams may be used on a daily basis in 'runs' lasting a week or more.

Following a single oral dose of 10 mg amphetamine sulfate, a reported peak blood concentration of 40 ng/mL was reached at 2 hr. Following a single 30 mg dose to adults, an average peak plasma level of 100 ng/mL was reported at 2.5 hr. A steady-state blood level of 2000-3000 ng/mL was reported in an addict who consumed approximately 1000 mg daily.

Overdose with amphetamine can produce restlessness, hyperthermia, convulsions, hallucinations, respiratory and/or cardiac failure. Reported blood concentrations in amphetamine-related fatalities ranged from 500-41000 ng/mL (mean 9000 ng/mL).

2. Fentanyl (Duragesic®; Sublimaze®) - Femoral Blood:

Fentanyl is a prescription opioid commonly used as an anesthetic/analgesic. It is reported to be 80 to 200 times as potent as morphine and has a rapid onset of action as well as addictive properties. Illicit fentanyl is readily available due to low production cost and its high potency. It is often sold as heroin and is commonly found in combination with other illicit drugs. Signs associated with fentanyl toxicity include severe respiratory depression, muscle rigidity, seizures, hypotension, coma and death.

When used clinically as a transdermal preparation (25-100 mcg/hour patch), serum fentanyl concentrations up to 3.8 ng/mL have been reported within 24 hours. Following removal of the patch, serum fentanyl concentrations are reported to decrease with a mean elimination half-life of 17 hours (range, 13-22 hours). The mean peak plasma serum fentanyl concentration in adults given an 800 mcg oral transmucosal fentanyl preparation over 15 minutes is reported at 2.1 ng/mL (range, 1.4-3.0 ng/mL) at approximately 0.40 hours.

It is reported that patients lost consciousness at mean plasma levels of fentanyl of 34 ng/mL when infused with 75 mcg/Kg over a 15 min period; peak plasma levels averaged 50 ng/mL. In fatalities from fentanyl, blood concentrations are variable and have been reported as low as 3 ng/mL. Postmortem blood fentanyl concentrations ranged from 0.30-110 ng/mL (median 11 ng/mL) in 301 femoral blood specimens obtained from accidental drug overdose death investigations. These concentrations ranged from 9.7-41.3 ng/mL (median 17.2 ng/mL) in 7 fentanyl only cases in another published case series.

The blood to serum or plasma ratio is 0.8-1.0

#### **Reference Comments:**

3. Methamphetamine - Femoral Blood:

d-Methamphetamine is a DEA schedule II stimulant drug capable of causing hallucinations, aggressive behavior and irrational reactions. Chemically, there are two forms (isomers) of methamphetamine: I- and d-methamphetamine. The I-isomer is used in non-prescription inhalers as a decongestant and has weak CNS-stimulatory activity. The d-isomer has been used therapeutically as an anorexigenic agent in the treatment of obesity and has potent CNS-, cardiac- and circulatory-stimulatory activity. Amphetamine and norephedrine (phenylpropanolamine) are metabolites of methamphetamine. d-Methamphetamine is an abused substance because of its stimulatory effects and is also addictive.

A peak blood concentration of methamphetamine of 20 ng/mL was reported at 2.5 hr after an oral dosage of 12.5 mg. Blood levels of 200-600 ng/mL have been reported in methamphetamine abusers who exhibited violent and irrational behavior. High doses of methamphetamine can also elicit restlessness, confusion, hallucinations, circulatory collapse and convulsions.

\*In this case, the level of methamphetamine determined has not been differentiated according to its isomeric forms. Differentiation of the isomers of methamphetamine is available upon request.

Norfentanyl (Fentanyl Metabolite) - Femoral Blood:

Norfentanyl is the primary inactive metabolite of the synthetic narcotic analgesic fentanyl.

On August 27, 2025, at approximately 11:00 AM, Tennessee Bureau of Investigation (TBI) Special Agent (SA) Steven Kennard received various items from Medical Examiner's (ME) Office Evidence Technician, Danielle Caceres. The items are from the autopsy of KEITH WEST and are as follows:

Upon receipt, all items received had been pre-packaged by personnel with the ME's office. SA Kennard signed the ME evidence list and was provided with a copy. A TBI property receipt was also completed for continued chain of custody purposes. Per ME's Office policy, the evidence Techs have been directed not to sign the TBI property receipt.

After receipt, the items were immediately transferred to the TBI Evidence Management Unit where they were transferred to be stored in the Criminal Investigation Division (CID) vault. Prior to the transfer, SA Kennard packaged the evidence in TBI evidence bags. All evidence was placed in temporary evidence locker #7 outside Evidence Management at approximately 12:20 PM along with the existing TBI property receipt. At approximately 2:00 PM, Evidence Manager Leslie Hall removed the items and transferred them to the CID vault. The property receipt was completed by Hall and the original copy was returned to SA Kennard. A digital copy of both the ME evidence list and the TBI property receipt will be attached to this report within the case file.



On Wednesday, June 8, 2025, Tennessee Bureau of Investigation (TBI) Special Agent (SA) Steven Kennard responded to the TBI Evidence Management Unit and removed the plastic pistol recovered from the crime scene associated with this investigation. After a conversation with District Attorney, Glenn Funk, it was determined that the firearm would be submitted to the TBI Firearms Unit for analysis. The purpose of this activity is to document the exact capabilities and make-up of the firearm.

Prior to submitting the firearm, SA Kennard contacted Forensic Scientist - Manager Connor Lamberson to see of this activity was appropriate given the fact that the firearm was clearly plastic and did not operate as a true firearm. He advised that this would be appropriate and that unit had completed this type of analysis on similar items before.

At approximately 12:00 PM, SA Kennard removed the item from Evidence Management and attempted to locate and identifying information on the item. All that was on the firearm was "Desert Eagle SOAE Plstol, Isreal Military Industres (I.M.I)" on one side of the frame, and "Magnum Research Inc Minneapolis Minn Made in Isreal" on the other side of the frame. There were no serial numbers or other identifiers on the pistol. A quick internet search did confirm that there is an airsoft-style toy pistol with these same markings on them. The toy can be either battery powered, CO2, or gas powered, and shoot small plastic orange projectiles which seem to have a limited range.

SA Kennard completed a request for exam form and submitted the pistol to the TBI lab at approximately 12:20 PM. The completed Request for Exam form will be attached to this report within the casefile.
