On November 7, 2025, at approximately 12:38 PM, TBI Special Agent (SA) Jonathan McGowen issued TBI Subpoena #35241 and related attachment to Greyhound Bus Lines in relation to this ongoing investigation. The subpoena was for any Greyhound passenger records or travel information related to BRADLEY TARNOR.

On November 24, 2025, at approximately 1:37 PM, SA McGowen received an email communication of subpoena results from Greyhound/Flixbus Bus Lines. A copy of all the recovered documents will be maintained in the digital case file.

Upon reviewing ticket information, it appears BRADLEY TARNOR started his travels in Fort Myers, Florida on November 5, 2025. It appears TARNOR arrived in Nashville on November 7th at approximately 4 AM. It appears TARNOR was set to board a Greyhound bus to Madisonville, Kentucky from Nashville at 9:10 AM on November 7, 2025.

Narrative:

On November 7, 2025, at approximately 12:38 PM, TBI Special Agent (SA) Jonathan McGowen issued TBI Subpoena #35241 and related attachment to Greyhound Bus Lines in relation to this ongoing investigation. The subpoena was for exterior and interior video surveillance from the Greyhound Bus Station located at 709 Rep. John Lewis Way South in Nashville, Tennessee.

On November 17, 2025, at approximately 3 PM, after coordination with local Greyhound bus station management, SA McGowen returned to the Greyhound Bus Station seeking to recover video surveillance in relation to this investigation. SA McGowen made contact with Greyhound management who granted access to the video surveillance system.

From a review of the location video surveillance views, it appears that exterior Camera 30 captured this related incident. Camera 9 appears to capture the bus station interior lobby areas near the main entrance.

Upon observation of video surveillance system time, SA McGowen noted at 4:29 PM, the video surveillance system time displayed 16:32 hours. SA McGowen noted the video surveillance system time appeared to be approximately 3 minutes faster than actual time.

SA McGowen recovered the below listed video surveillance data via TBI USB drive.

1. Digital Data – Video Surveillance
 - a. 77 files of video surveillance and logs
 - i. Cameras 30 and 9

Due to the voluminous nature of this digital data, it will be maintained in the digital case file.

Upon review of relevant Camera 30 video surveillance footage, it appears the first marked MNPD vehicle with activated blue lights arrived within camera view at approximately 06:10:46 hours system time, with the second marked MNPD vehicle arriving seconds later. The

involved person (TARNOR) appears to begin running towards officers at approximately 06:11:02 hours. A screen capture of this video surveillance viewpoint will be attached to this report.

Narrative:

On November 13, 2025, at approximately 11:50 AM, Tennessee Bureau of Investigation (TBI) Special Agent (SA) Steven Kennard interviewed GREY MAXWELL at the Tennessee Bureau of Investigation (TBI) headquarters located at 901 R.S. Gass Boulevard in Nashville, Tennessee. Also present were SA Jonathan McGowen and attorney John Brown. The interview was audio recorded, and a copy will be provided to the District Attorney's Office upon request. After proper identification and explanation of the purpose of the interview, MAXWELL voluntarily provided an audio recording. The following is a synopsis of that interview:

MAXWELL is currently with the Metro Nashville Police Department (MNPD) and is a patrol officer on Central Precinct C-detail. He has been with MNPD for approximately three years. He has been on patrol the entire time. He has not worked for any other law enforcement agencies. MAXWELL has not had any other use-of-force incidents involving a firearm, baton, or OC. He has had one instance where he used his taser which was documented. MAXWELL has not had any disciplinary instances involving use of force while in the department.

Regarding this use of force incident, MAXWELL had just finished up a call at around 6:00 AM and was in a parking lot at 9th and Clark place when the call came in. A call for a "54" or person with a weapon came in at 709 Rep John Lewis Way which is in MAXWELL's zone. The details said that a male called in saying he had a gun in his backpack and that he was feeling violent. MAXWELL took the call and turned on his lights and sirens and went to the call. He went south on Lafayette and was attempting to get more information regarding the description of the subject. He turned right on Rep John Lewis Way which pulls in front of the Greyhound Bus Station which was on the right.

MAXWELL pulled in alongside the sidewalk and his partner pulled in from the opposite direction. MAXWELL exited his vehicle and looked around. As he turned and looked down towards Lafayette Street, a male emerged and was running towards him. The subject was looking directly at MAXWELL and had a backpack on his chest, front-facing, and had his hand down in the backpack where MAXWELL couldn't see it. The subject runs towards them, and he hears the subject say, "I have a gun". MAXWELL says "get it out" indicating that he wanted the subject to show his hands which the subject did not comply with. The subject got to about five to ten feet away. MAXWELL initially thought

to reach for his taser and then drew his pistol given the information that the subject said he had a gun in his backpack. The subject made a sudden motion indicating that he was going to present a firearm. When he did this, MAXWELL fired on the subject. He is unsure how many rounds he fired. MAXWELL's partner also fired at the subject. After firing, the subject looked to have taken some of the rounds. He fell to the ground at which time MAXWELL stopped firing. His partner advised he would cover and MAXWELL searched the subject for a firearm which he did not find. After this, they began rendering aid. MAXWELL saw what he thought were at least two gunshot wounds. They began to dress the wounds when other officers arrived to assist. Medical personnel arrived as well and took over rendering aid. After the shooting, MAXWELL stepped back and observed until supervisors arrived. MAXWELL was told to get in his vehicle and sit there by himself.

It was MAXWELL's understanding that this person called dispatch directly. The details that stood out were that the subject had a gun in his backpack and that he was feeling violent. There was no clothing description or demographic description given. The information about the backpack was given.

MAXWELL was in his normal, marked police vehicle. He had his lights and siren activated while responding. He was wearing his normal patrol uniform. He was clearly marked as a police officer. The incident occurred in the street in front of the bus station in the middle of the street.

When MAXWELL initially exited his vehicle, the subject came around a vehicle at the end of the street. He was running towards MAXWELL and appeared to be running with a purpose directly towards MAXWELL. He was making eye contact with MAXWELL and had his hand down in a backpack. MAXWELL's thought process was when he saw the man with the backpack running towards him, he thought that this was the guy who called. Based on the information that the subject was feeling violent and had a gun, MAXWELL knew he had to draw his firearm. The quick movement by the subject registered with MAXWELL that the subject was about to pull a handgun out and attempt to kill MAXWELL or his partner. MAXWELL was also considering the subjects at the bus station behind him that would have been in danger if the subject pulled the gun. Based on this, MAXWELL decided to fire his weapon.

MAXWELL thinks he shot maybe two or three times. His partner, RYAN YNZUNZA also fired at the same time. YNZUNZA was standing to his right about five to ten feet away. The individual ran up almost in between the two.

Based on the situation and information MAXWELL had, no other tool would have been effective other than his firearm. This was based on the fact that the subject stated he had a firearm.

MAXWELL had body and vehicle cameras that were operational at the time. The vehicle may not have captured the incident based on the way the vehicle was facing. MAXWELL has seen the publicly released bodycam footage prior to the interview. MAXWELL's call sign was 423C on that shift. MAXWELL was not given the opportunity to talk to anyone else before or after the incident occurred. MAXWELL has never seen the individual with the backpack before this incident. The subject said he had a gun as he approached. After the shooting, MAXWELL doesn't recall the subject saying anything. MAXWELL did not clear the backpack that the subject was carrying, but other officers may have. As far as he knows, a firearm was not located. The subject was a white male, approximately 5'8 or 5'9 and medium build with a black backpack.

The information above is meant to be a summary only and not intended to be an exact transcript of the interview. A copy of the above-mentioned interview will be maintained with the case agent in the working case file.

Narrative:

On November 13, 2025, at approximately 10:20 AM, Tennessee Bureau of Investigation (TBI) Special Agent (SA) Steven Kennard interviewed RYAN YNZUNZA at the Tennessee Bureau of Investigation (TBI) headquarters located at 901 R.S. Gass Boulevard in Nashville, Tennessee. Also present were SA Jonathan McGowen and attorneys' Doug Thibodeaux and Kim Gilliland. The interview was audio recorded, and a copy will be provided to the District Attorney's Office upon request. After proper identification and explanation of the purpose of the interview, YNZUNZA voluntarily provided an audio recording. The following is a synopsis of that interview:

YNZUNZA is a police officer for the Metro Nashville Police Department (MNPD) and has been there for three years. He left for about four months but then came back. He has been a patrol officer his entire time with MNPD. He is currently assigned to Central Precinct C-Detail.

Prior to his time with MNPD, YNZUNZA was a military police officer for five years. He got out in 2012. In 2018, he went back as a civilian police officer for the Marine Corp for four years prior to coming to MNPD.

For prior use of force incidents with MNPD, YNZUNZA has not used his taser, asp, or OC spray. He has pulled his pistol approximately six times but has not used it at all before this incident. YNZUNZA has had no previous firearm use in his previous employment. YNZUNZA has not had any disciplinary history regarding use of force in his time with MNPD.

Regarding this incident, YNZUNZA had just finished a call in the area and was working on a report. He heard the call come out about someone who was looking to hurt themselves. YNZUNZA waited just a minute to give others time to get closer and then proceeded that way. He had his lights and sirens activated on the way. He pulled up to the scene at the same time MAXWELL did. YNZUNZA looked towards the sidewalk at the bus station and didn't see anything. He proceeded to get out along with MAXWELL. YNZUNZA went to get his phone and heard MAXWELL yelling at someone. He looked and saw a guy coming towards MAXWELL with a backpack in his front, and his hand in the backpack. YNZUNZA drew his firearm and yelled something to the subject like "let me see your hands" or something similar when the subject pulled his hand out of the backpack and pointed it in a

shooting motion towards MAXWELL. YNZUNZA was afraid for MAXWELL and so he fired to defend him. YNZUNZA isn't sure how many times he shot. He saw the subject fall to the ground. They handcuffed him and started to render aid. MAXWELL looked for a gun and said that he didn't find one. YNZUNZA saw a wound on the subject's right side and one on his left. He administered CPR until personnel from the fire department arrived at which time he got out of the way. A day shift Sergeant arrived, and YNZUNZA told him what happened. He and MAXWELL were separated and he went and sat in his car until his representation arrived.

YNZUNZA remembers that the details of the call said that the subject had a gun in his backpack. That's why when he saw the subject pressing towards MAXWELL with his hand in his backpack, he drew his firearm.

When YNZUNZA was on the way to the scene, he used his lights and siren. He was in a marked police vehicle and was in his standard police uniform. He was wearing a bodycam and had in-car camera. He hasn't watched either, but has seen the press release which showed some bodycam footage. When YNZUNZA arrived, he was facing north on Rep John Lewis Way. MAXWELL pulled in from the opposite direction, but they parked next to each other. When YNZUNZA exited his vehicle, the subject was already approaching MAXWELL. They were in the street and both facing the subject.

Based on the details of someone having a gun, when YNZUNZA arrived and saw someone yelling, he went into auditory exclusion. He saw the subject with his hand in his backpack and pull it out, that's when he fired some rounds. He did this in defense of MAXWELL because he thought the subject was pointing a gun at MAXWELL. That's why he took the action he did. YNZUNZA isn't sure if MAXWELL was giving him commands or not. After the subject was shot, YNZUNZA didn't hear him say anything. The threat was when the subject quickly pulled his hand out of the bag and had it shaped like a gun. Given the situation, they had no time to try and de-escalate or anything else. There was no other option other than what he did that would be appropriate for the situation.

The subject was a white male with fine straight brown hair. He was wearing a red shirt and khaki pants. He had a black backpack in front of him. YNZUNZA did not see a gun or any other weapon on his person. He didn't go through the backpack. YNZUNZA is unaware of any other witnesses who saw it. There were people in front of the bus station, but he tuned them out as he was rendering aid. YNZUNZA didn't talk to anyone while he was out there. YNZUNZA has never seen this individual before this incident.

Narrative:

On November 8, 2025, at approximately 3:00 PM, Tennessee Bureau of Investigation (TBI) Special Agent (SA) Steven Kennard spoke by telephone with Jim Mulligan. Mulligan is the stepfather of BRADLEY TARNOR. Mulligan and his wife live in Cape Coral, Florida.

According to Mulligan, TARNOR had been living in Sanford, Florida near Orlando until recently. He was headed to a rehab facility in Kentucky called Team Challenge and was traveling through Nashville on his way. TARNOR had been to this facility before and liked it. He had recently relapsed and was on his way back. TARNOR's drug of choice is crystal meth. He started using later in high school and has gone downhill ever since then. He has gotten clean and then relapsed multiple times.

TARNOR called his mom, Kelly (Johnson) Mulligan yesterday from the bus station. He said he was tired of disappointing everyone. TARNOR also spoke with his sister on the phone as well. TARNOR was in regular phone communication with his mother. TARNOR has no diagnosed mental illness that Mulligan knows of and is not on medications for it. TARNOR would get paranoid when he was using saying that "they were listening" which would mean that the police were listening. He has never tried to harm himself or made any threats to harm himself.

TARNOR did not have any access to firearms and had no interest as far as Mulligan knew. Mulligan thought that TARNOR had never even shot a gun. TARNOR had no problems with law-enforcement and trusted the police in general. Mulligan is a retired law-enforcement officer.

Narrative:

On November 8, 2025, Tennessee Bureau of Investigation (TBI) Special Agent (SA) Steven Kennard responded to the Vanderbilt Hospital Emergency Room located at 1211 Medical Center Drive in Nashville, Tennessee. The purpose of the visit was to retrieve clothing belonging to BRADLEY TARNOR. At approximately 12:55 PM, SA Kennard met with SANE Nurse Dawn Hawley who had secured the items in a secured locker inside her office. She retrieved the items which were sealed in a paper bag inside a plastic bag due to bio-hazard material on the paper bag. The items were left in the plastic bag at this time and taken back to the TBI headquarters and stored in the Criminal Investigation Division (CID) temporary storage lockers until they could be moved to TBI Evidence Management.

On November 13, 2025, the package was removed from CID temporary storage locker and inventoried. The items inside the bag were as follows:

- Two (2) black shoes
- Two (2) black socks
- Black underwear

After the items were inventoried, they were placed back in the original packaging and then packaged in a TBI evidence bag and labeled accordingly. The package was then taken to TBI Evidence Management where it was placed in the exterior temporary evidence lockers. The bag was placed in Locker #2 along with the property receipt.

PRELIMINARY INVESTIGATIVE REPORT:

This case is predicated on a verbal request by District Attorney General for the 20th Judicial District, Glenn Funk on Friday, November 7, 2025. General Funk requested agents for the Tennessee Bureau of Investigation (TBI) investigate the facts and circumstances surrounding an officer-involved shooting that occurred at the intersection of 709 Rep John Lewis Way S. in Nashville, Tennessee earlier on this date involving an officer with the Metro Nashville Police Department (MNPD). General Funk will be following up with a written request at a later date.

At approximately 6:30 AM, TBI Special Agent in Charge (ASAC) Josh Savley contacted TBI Special Agent (SA) Steven Kennard and requested he respond to the above-mentioned location to gather facts and details of a shooting that occurred. Preliminary information advised that officers (later identified as RYAN YNZUNZA and GREY MAXWELL) with MNPD had a confrontation with an unknown subject (later identified as BRADLEY SHANE TARNOR) resulting in TARNOR being shot.

At approximately 7:50 AM, SA Kennard arrived on the scene. SAC Savley was already on scene with several other field agents. The scene was the roadway in front of the Greyhound Bus Station at the above-mentioned address. SA Kennard made contact with MNPD Cold Case Detective Elizabeth Rucker who is assigned as the MNPD liaison for this incident. SA Kennard was given a brief synopsis of the event which preliminarily revealed that TARNOR was at the bus station and called the 911 emergency line and said he was "feeling crazy" and requested police response. When officers arrived, TARNOR approached the officers and said that he had a gun. He was holding a backpack and was approaching the officers with his hand in the bag. He moved quickly towards the officers, which resulted in the officers firing their pistols at him and striking him. TARNOR was provided with medical support and was ultimately transported to Vanderbilt hospital where he was pronounced deceased.

The scene had already been secured with crime scene tape, and several witnesses had been identified. Agents had begun the process of crime scene processing as well.

This investigation is continuing.

On Monday, November 8, 2025, Tennessee Bureau of Investigation (TBI) Special Agent (SA) Steven Kennard responded to the Davidson County Medical Examiner's Office located at 850 R.S. Gass Boulevard in Nashville, Tennessee to attend the autopsy of BRADLEY TARNOR. SA Kennard arrived at approximately 10:30. The autopsy was performed by Dr. Scott Collier.

Dr. Collier pointed out what he presumed to be gunshot wounds on the body of TARNOR which are as follows:

- A wound on the left side of the chest moving laterally across the chest cavity with what appeared to be an exit wound on the right side of the chest.
- A wound on the upper chest/neck area going straight in
- A wound that appeared to be an entry and exit wound on the right forearm
- A similar entry and exit wound on the back.

There were no other wounds noted.

Dr. Collier was able to retrieve a spent projectile from the wound in the upper chest/neck area. No other projectiles were recovered as all other wounds were thought to have an entry and exit. After the inspection of the inside of the body cavity, Dr. Collier advised the wound path in the chest struck both the heart and lungs, which would most likely be a fatal wound.

The projectile was recovered and will be retrieved by SA Kennard at a later date.

GARRETT is a security guard with Hilton Security, who was on duty at the Greyhound bus station. GARRETT worked a security shift from 10 PM to 6 AM.

GARRETT observed the initial police vehicle arrive at the bus station with its lights on. GARRETT advises this caught his attention so he walked out the bus station front doors towards the police vehicle seeking to learn who called and be of any help to the officer. GARRETT believes another police vehicle also arrived parking across the street.

GARRETT says once the initial officer exited the police vehicle, a white male ran up holding a backpack, with his other hand concealed in the backpack. He recalls the officer demanding the male to drop the bag, to which the male responded "I got a gun". GARRETT explains that he couldn't see the male's hand within the backpack.

GARRETT says then there were "fireworks"(gunshots). He believes each officer may have fired approximately four times each, though there was some overlap.

When asked, GARRETT explains that he was standing outside on the sidewalk when this incident occurred. GARRETT doesn't believe anyone from the Greyhound station contacted police to respond.

GARRETT doesn't recall seeing the male white previously at the bus station, but has heard from other passengers that the male had arrived earlier on a Greyhound bus.

After the shooting, GARRETT recalls officers providing CPR and medical care until the ambulance arrived.

AGENTS NOTE: After this interview, agents learned that Mr. Coleman's vehicle a Buick Lacrosse sedan bearing Tennessee plate [REDACTED] was parked in front of the bus station.

On 11/7/2025 at 7:49am, Coley Ryan Logan was interviewed by the reporting agent at the Greyhound Station at 709 Rep. John Lewis Way, Nashville, TN, in Davidson County. After proper identification and explanation of the purpose for the interview, LOGAN voluntarily provided a statement. The recording has been saved and is in the custody of SA Moseley and will be released to the District Attorney upon request. The following is a brief synopsis of the interview:

Mr. LOGAN did not know the gunshot victim. He met this individual on a Greyhound Bus from Atlanta to Nashville. Mr. LOGAN stated that this individual asked two guys behind him on the bus, "you guys are not going to stab me are you?" They said no and this individual told them that he was not in the right headspace and was just making sure. Once at the Greyhound Station, this individual again stated that he was not in the right headspace and he spent most of his time outside of the Greyhound Station, and Mr. LOGAN was inside of the Station. Mr. LOGAN did hear this individual state that he had to quiet his thoughts as he was outside of the Greyhound Station talking to himself.

Mr. LOGAN stated that he did not witness the officer-involved shooting but after he heard approximately 4-5 shots, he looked out of the window and observed the officers administer CPR on this individual.
