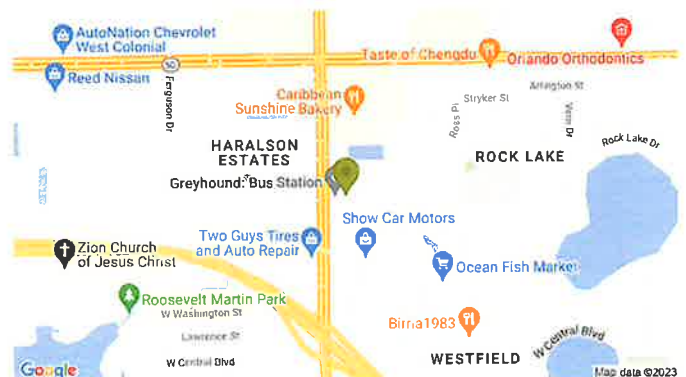

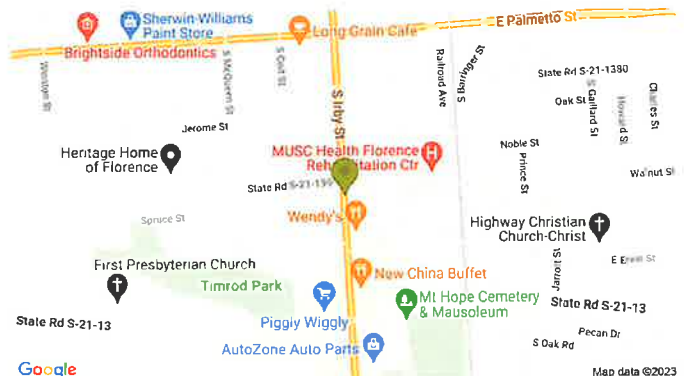

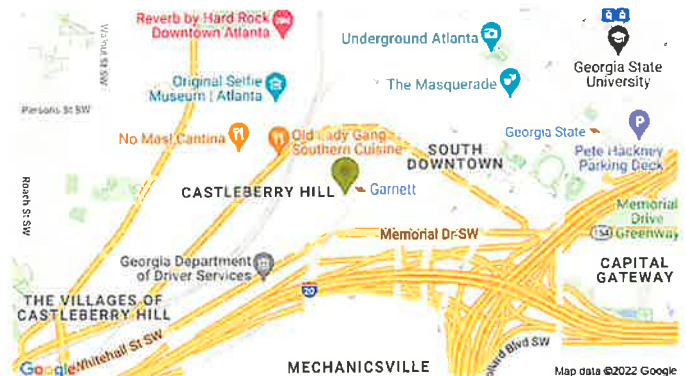

The autopsy was performed at the Center for Forensic Medicine. The purpose of this report is to provide a certified opinion to the County Medical Examiner and District Attorney General. The facts and findings to support these conclusions are filed with the Tennessee Department of Health. The autopsy was performed in the presence of Shannon Crook, M.D.

EVIDENCE OF INJURY - *The following description reflects the order in which the injuries were examined and is not intended to indicate the order in which they may have occurred.*

1. Multiple Gunshot Wounds

A. Gunshot wound of the right shoulder:

Located on the anterior aspect of the right shoulder, 30.0 centimeters below the vertex of the head and 12.0 centimeters to the right of the anterior midline is a 0.5 x 0.5 centimeter, entrance-type gunshot wound. The wound has an eccentric red abrasion and no soot or gunpowder stipple. The bullet perforated the muscle and soft tissue of the right shoulder and back, and the right subclavian artery. A deformed, jacketed bullet is recovered from the muscle of the back. The bullet is secured in a sealed evidence envelope labeled "Bullet from back" with the decedent's name and case number. With the body in standard anatomic position the trajectory is front to back and downwards.

B. Gunshot wound of the chest:

Located on the right lateral aspect of the chest, 41.0 centimeters below the vertex of the head and 15.5 centimeters to the right of the anterior midline is a 0.6 x 0.5 centimeter, entrance-type gunshot wound. The wound has a concentric red abrasion and no soot or gunpowder stipple. The bullet perforated the muscle and soft tissue of the chest, the anterior aspect of the right 3rd rib, the upper lobe of the right lung, the right atrium of the heart, the upper lobe of the left lung, and the anterior aspect of the left 2nd intercostal space. The bullet exited the left lateral aspect of the chest, 33.0 centimeters below the vertex of the head and 16.5 centimeters to the left of the anterior midline through a 1.2 x 0.7 centimeter, exit-type gunshot wound with lacerated edges. No bullet is recovered from the wound. With the body in standard anatomic position the trajectory is right to left and upwards.

C. Gunshot wound of the back:

Located on the right lower aspect of the back, 65.0 centimeters below the vertex of the head and 14.0 centimeters to the right of the posterior midline is a 1.2 x 0.6 centimeter, entrance-type gunshot wound. The wound has an eccentric red-brown abrasion and no soot or gunpowder stipple. The bullet perforated the muscle and soft tissue of the back. The bullet exited the right lower aspect of the back, 65.0 centimeters below the vertex of the head and 3.5 centimeters to the right of the posterior midline through a 1.5 x 0.7 centimeter, exit-type gunshot wound with lacerated edges. No bullet is recovered from the wound. With the body in standard anatomic position the trajectory is right to left.

D. Gunshot wound of the right forearm:

Located on the anterolateral aspect of the right forearm, 40.5 centimeters below the top of the right shoulder is a 0.8 x 0.4 centimeter, entrance-type gunshot wound. The

wound has an eccentric red abrasion and no soot or gunpowder stipple. The bullet perforated the muscle and soft tissue of the right forearm. The bullet exited the anterior aspect of the right forearm, 37.0 centimeters below the top of the right shoulder through a 1.5 x 1.2 centimeter, exit-type gunshot wound with lacerated edges. No bullet is recovered from the wound. With the body in standard anatomic position the trajectory is right to left and upwards.

COMMENT: Due to extensive medical intervention involving the chest, any additional injuries may be obscured.

2. Other Injuries: A 1.5 centimeter tan abrasion involves the left knee. A contused area of multiple tan abrasions up to 0.3 centimeters in on the anterior aspect of the right leg.

EXTERNAL EXAMINATION - *Injuries are described in "EVIDENCE OF INJURY"*

Rigor: Present in the jaw, neck, and extremities.
Livor: Consistent with body position, fixed.
Algor: Cold.
Length: 70 inches.
Weight: 170 pounds.
BMI: 24.4 kg/m²
Hair: Brown scalp hair. Facial hair consists of a goatee and stubble.
Eyes: Hazel.
Dentition: Natural.
Scars: As photographed and diagrammed.
Therapy: Endotracheal tube; intravascular catheter in left antecubital fossa; intraosseous catheter in right shoulder; bilateral thoracotomies; hospital identification band on left ankle; and hospital toe tag tied to right great toe.

General: The decedent is received in a body bag. The bag is opened to reveal the unembalmed body of a well-nourished, well-developed adult male who appears consistent with the reported age. The corneas are cloudy, the sclerae are tan-white, and the conjunctivae are pale with no petechiae or hemorrhage. The external auditory canals and nares are free of debris and lesions. The lips and mouth are uninjured and the frenula are intact. The neck is free of trauma. The chest and back are normally formed. The abdomen has no palpable masses. The external genitalia and anus appear uninjured. The fingernails are intact. The extremities are well-developed and symmetrical.

INTERNAL EXAMINATION - *Injuries are described in "EVIDENCE OF INJURY"*

GENERAL: The body is opened by a standard Y-shaped thoraco-abdominal incision. All examined body organs are in their normal anatomical positions.

Heart: 240 grams
Right lung: 330 grams
Left lung: 320 grams
Liver: 1320 grams
Spleen: 150 grams
Right kidney: 130 grams
Left kidney: 130 grams

NERVOUS SYSTEM: The scalp has no hematomas. The calvarium and basilar skull have no fractures. The dura mater and falx cerebri are intact. There is no epidural, subdural, or subarachnoid hemorrhage. The leptomeninges are thin, delicate and translucent. The cerebral hemispheres are symmetrical. The vessels at the base of the brain are intact and have no evidence of aneurysm or thrombosis and have no significant atherosclerosis. Cut surfaces of the cerebrum show good demarcation of gray and white matter. There are no space occupying lesions or hemorrhage. The deep nuclei of the brain and the bilateral hippocampi are normally formed. The cut surfaces of the midbrain, medulla, pons and cerebellum are grossly unremarkable.

NECK STRUCTURES: The cervical spine is structurally intact. The hyoid bone and thyroid and cricoid cartilages are intact. The soft tissues and strap muscles have no abnormalities. The larynx is clear.

CARDIOVASCULAR SYSTEM: See EVIDENCE OF INJURY.

RESPIRATORY SYSTEM: See EVIDENCE OF INJURY.

DIGESTIVE SYSTEM: The tongue is atraumatic. The oropharynx is unobstructed. The esophagus is lined by gray-white, smooth mucosa. The gastroesophageal junction is well-defined. The stomach is normal in size and shape and contains approximately 120 milliliters of tan fluid. The gastric mucosa has no ulcerations or masses. The small and large intestines and the appendix are grossly unremarkable. The pancreas is pink-tan and the lobular architecture is intact.

HEPATOBIILIARY SYSTEM: The liver has a smooth, glistening, intact capsule covering dark-brown parenchyma with no focal lesions. The portal vein, hepatic artery, and hepatic veins are patent. The gallbladder contains a small amount of viscid bile and no calculi. The gallbladder mucosa is green and velvety. The extrahepatic bile ducts are patent.

HEMATOPOIETIC SYSTEM: The spleen has a smooth, intact capsule covering red-purple, firm parenchyma. Regional lymph nodes have a normal distribution and appearance.

URINARY SYSTEM: The renal capsules are smooth, thin, and semi-transparent and cover smooth, red-brown cortical surfaces. The renal cortices are normal in thickness, slightly congested, and have well delineated corticomedullary junctions. The calyces, pelves, and ureters are not dilated. The urinary bladder contains more than 60 milliliters of urine and the bladder mucosa is gray-tan and wrinkled.

REPRODUCTIVE SYSTEM: The testes have tan parenchyma without evidence of trauma. The prostate gland has firm, tan-white parenchyma and is not enlarged.

ENDOCRINE SYSTEM: The pituitary, thyroid, and adrenal glands are grossly unremarkable.

MUSCULOSKELETAL SYSTEM: The musculature is normally developed. The bony skeleton is injured as previously described.

ADDITIONAL PROCEDURES

Toxicology: Samples of vitreous fluid, urine, and postmortem blood are submitted for toxicology analysis. See separate report.

Evidence Collected: Documentary photographs, blood spot card, portions of tissue retained in 10% formalin, and recovered projectile.

Radiographs: Performed and reviewed.

Clothing: The body is received unclad.

SUMMARY AND INTERPRETATION

This 30-year-old man, identified as Bradley Tarnor, was reportedly shot during an altercation with law enforcement. Emergency medical services responded and transported him to Vanderbilt Medical Center where death was pronounced shortly after arrival.

Autopsy examination had findings of multiple gunshot wounds with devastating injuries to the right subclavian artery, lungs and heart.

Based on all currently known and available information, the cause of death is best attributed to gunshot wounds, and the manner of death is homicide.

Reference Comments:

1. Amphetamine - Femoral Blood:

Amphetamine (Adderall, Dexedrine) is a central nervous system stimulant. Amphetamine is also a metabolite of methamphetamine, benzphetamine and selegiline. It is used therapeutically in the treatment of narcolepsy and obesity and also in the treatment of attention-deficit hyperactivity disorder (ADHD). Amphetamine has a high potential for abuse. At low doses, amphetamine causes mild stimulation, offset of fatigue, and increase in alertness. It also causes changes in attitude, judgment and impulsivity. At higher doses, amphetamine causes euphoria, excitation, agitation, hypervigilance, rapid speech, dilated pupils which react slowly to light and increased motor restlessness. Pulse and blood pressure may be elevated. Withdrawal from amphetamine following abuse can result in extreme fatigue and uncontrollable sleepiness, agitation, and depression. In the treatment of narcolepsy, amphetamine is administered in daily divided doses of 5 to 60 mg. In abuse doses of several grams may be used on a daily basis in 'runs' lasting a week or more.

Following a single oral dose of 10 mg amphetamine sulfate, a reported peak blood concentration of 40 ng/mL was reached at 2 hr. Following a single 30 mg dose to adults, an average peak plasma level of 100 ng/mL was reported at 2.5 hr. A steady-state blood level of 2000-3000 ng/mL was reported in an addict who consumed approximately 1000 mg daily.

Overdose with amphetamine can produce restlessness, hyperthermia, convulsions, hallucinations, respiratory and/or cardiac failure. Reported blood concentrations in amphetamine-related fatalities ranged from 500-41000 ng/mL (mean 9000 ng/mL).

2. Methamphetamine - Femoral Blood:

d-Methamphetamine is a DEA schedule II stimulant drug capable of causing hallucinations, aggressive behavior and irrational reactions. Chemically, there are two forms (isomers) of methamphetamine: l- and d-methamphetamine. The l-isomer is used in non-prescription inhalers as a decongestant and has weak CNS-stimulatory activity. The d-isomer has been used therapeutically as an anorexigenic agent in the treatment of obesity and has potent CNS-, cardiac- and circulatory-stimulatory activity. Amphetamine and norephedrine (phenylpropanolamine) are metabolites of methamphetamine. d-Methamphetamine is an abused substance because of its stimulatory effects and is also addictive.

A peak blood concentration of methamphetamine of 20 ng/mL was reported at 2.5 hr after an oral dosage of 12.5 mg. Blood levels of 200-600 ng/mL have been reported in methamphetamine abusers who exhibited violent and irrational behavior. High doses of methamphetamine can also elicit restlessness, confusion, hallucinations, circulatory collapse and convulsions.

*In this case, the level of methamphetamine determined has not been differentiated according to its isomeric forms. Differentiation of the isomers of methamphetamine is available upon request.
