On 03/23/2024 at approximately 10:19 PM, I was dispatched to the Infinity Lofts Apartments at [REDACTED] for a call for service regarding an individual attempting to break into the building. I arrived on scene and was motioned to come over by an individual that matched the description of the suspect and who was standing by the door. During the course of speaking with the individual, who was the suspect, he became hostile and aggressive and jumped in my face after he attempted to walk away from officers and I put my hand up in front of him and told him he was not free to leave. After he jumped up into my face, I determined in regards to officer safety to detain the suspect and I told him to put his hands behind his back. Myself, Officer Adcox, and Officers Dmitriyev attempted to place the suspect into cuffs, The suspect immediately resisted arrest by not allowing his arms to go behind him and he pulled his arms towards his chest after we grabbed the suspect's arms. I grabbed his right arm and was using soft empty hand control to attempt to manipulate his arm behind him. I was unsuccessful in bringing his arm behind him and I determined he would have to be escorted down to the ground and told the other officers on scene the plan. Myself and the other officers then escorted the suspect down to the ground and began trying to roll him onto his stomach. While trying to get the suspect turned over so handcuffs could be placed on him, the suspect continued to resist and would not allow us to turn him over. The suspect then threw two punches, one of which struck Officer Adcox in the face, who then used hard empty hand control and struck the suspect back, which was ineffective. Myself and Officer Adcox then decided to deploy our tasers, and I pulled mine out and turned it on and aimed it at the suspect's back side, who was on his side at this point and still refusing to turn over. Officer Adcox warned the suspect that unless her rolled over onto his stomach and complied, he was going to get tased. The suspect refused to comply. I ordered the suspect to turn around, which he refused again. At that point, I lifted the back of the suspect's shirt up to ensure a better connection with the taser probes and then fired my taser. The taser deployment was effective and we were able to get the suspect rolled onto his stomach and his hands placed into handcuffs. The suspect was eventually transported to Nashville General by Nashville Fire Department, and officers issued the suspect a taser aftercare notice before he was admitted into booking.

POLICE WERE DISPATCHED [REDACTED] FOR A MALE BLACK SUBJECT ATTEMPTING TO GET INSIDE THE BUILDING. UPON ARRIVAL, POLICE MADE CONTACT WITH THE SUBJECT, ANTHONY SEATS. THE SUBJECT STATED TO POLICE THAT HE LIVES AT THE LOCATION, POLICE ASK WHAT IS HIS APARTMENT NUMBER AND SUBJECT STATED TO POLICE "I DON'T KNOW, BUT I LIVE IN THIS BUILDING." POLICE ASK THE SUBJECT FOR IDENTIFICATION AND THE SUBJECT STATED THAT HE DOESN'T HAVE HIS IDEA AND TOLD POLICE THAT HIS NAME IS "RESTREPO LABO."

THE SUBJECT THEN ATTEMPTED TO LEAVE BUT POLICE INFORMED HIM THAT HE IS NOT FREE TO LEAVE. THE SUBJECT THEN YELLED IN OFFICER MAXWELL FACE, SAYING "I DIDN'T DO ANYTHING WRONG." POLICE ON SCENE THEN ATTEMPTED TO PLACE THE SUBJECT IN CUSTODY FOR DISORDERLY CONDUCT, BUT THE SUBJECT STARTED TO RESIST ARREST. WHILE THE SUBJECT WAS RESISITING ARREST, I WAS HOLDING THE SUBJECT BY THE LEGS.

THE SUBJECT HIT OFFICER ADCOX WITH A CLOSED FIST IN THE FACE TWICE. POLICE ON SCENE THEN TASED THE SUBJECT AND WAS ABLE TO PLACE HIM IN CUSTODY. WHILE IN CUSTODY, THE SUBJECT CONTINUE TO RESIST ARREST. THE SUBJECT SPIT ON OFFICER MAXWELL FACE AND CONTINUE TO SHOVE HIS ARMS AWAY FROM HIM. WHILE POLICE WAS PUTTING THE SUBJECT IN THE BACK OF A PATROL VEHICLE, THE SUBJECT KICKED OFFICER WILSON IN THE FACE. I WALKED AROUND TO THE OTHER SIDE OF THE VEHICLE TO PULL THE SUBJECT INSIDE THE VEHICLE AND HELD HIM DOWN ON HIS SHOULDERS UNTIL A HOBLE TIE WAS PLACED ON THE SUBJECT LEGS.

POLICE ON SCENE CALLED FOR MEDICS DUE TO THE SUBJECT BLEEDING FROM THE MOUTH. MEDICS ARRIVED ON SCENE AND ADVISED TO POLICE THAT THEY WILL TAKE THE SUBJECT TO NASHVILLE GENERAL FOR FURTHER TREATMENT. POLICE FOLLOWED MEDICS TO HOSPITAL WITH SUBJECT UNTIL HIS RELEASED TO TRANSPORT TO BOOKING. NO FURTHER INCIDENT HAD OCCURED.

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On 03/22/2024 officers responded to [REDACTED] for a 71P where a male was pulling on the entry way of apartment complex doors trying to get in. The suspect matching the description given was in the area and Officer Maxwell attempted to talk with him. The suspect yelled and was upset stating he lived there and just forgot all his belongings inside his residence. Officers tried to identify him, and he told officers a name which later was discovered to be a false name. The suspect then said he was leaving, and officers told him he was detained and not free to go. The suspect then walked in the direction of Officer Maxwell and a decision to arrest him was made. I grabbed his right arm helped to try and handcuff the individual. He started to resist and pull his arm away and officers did a controlled soft take down to get him to the prone position on the ground and handcuff him. The suspect continued to resist and got one of his hands free after moving away on the ground. The suspect struck Officer Adcox in the face after he got his hand free and continued to resist. Officers gave the suspect multiple verbal requests to stop and put his hands behind his back which he did not comply with. I attempted to maneuver his top half of his body back to the prone position for handcuffing. A decision to deploy the Taser was made to affect the arrest. The Taser was deployed on the suspects back and the suspect was quickly handcuffed. The suspect asked for his inhaler, and I administered it to him before we stood him up. When officers stood the suspect up, he continued to try kicking at officers and started to resist again. He spit at officers when he was standing up. He was faced towards a wall and Taser probes were removed from him. He continued to resist while being placed in the back of the police vehicle. His legs were tied with a hobble restraint due to him kicking. Officers called an ambulance for the suspect, and he wanted to be transported to the hospital. He was transported by NFD EMS to a hospital.
