On 06/14/2024, at approximately 0043 hours, Ofc. Babbar and I were conducting foot patrol in front of [REDACTED]. Officers observed the defendant, Mr. Driscoll and another individual in front of the business. The defendant then grabbed the individual by his shirt and then lifted the other individuals chin with his free hand. The defendant then smacked the individual in the face twice with an open hand slap. The defendant began wrestling with the other individual, which caused several rope barriers to be knocked over. Officers ordered the defendant to immediately stop and separate. The defendant continued to grab onto the other individual's shirt and ignore officer's orders.

Ofc. Babbar and myself then quickly approached. I then grabbed onto the defendant's left hand/arm with my right hand and pulled it away from the other individual, in order to separate the parties. Both officers stated that the defendant needed to walk away or back away from the incident. Ofc. Babbar had to physically shove the defendant in the chest in order to separate the two individuals. The defendant began yelling and cussing at officers stating that what he was doing was not wrong and that the other party was his friend. I then stated to the defendant to place his hands behind his back, while simultaneously reaching for his right wrist. The defendant quickly backed up into a wall and pulled both of his hands upward and away from officers. Ofc. Babbar then appeared to reach for the defendant's left arm. The defendant then lunged forward in an attempt to squeeze through both officers. Ofc. Babbar held onto the defendant's right arm, while I wrapped my arms around the defendant's upper shoulders. I then rotated the defendant quickly to the right and decentralized him to the ground and onto his stomach. The defendant continued to pull his arms towards his chest while on the ground in an attempt to prevent officers from placing his arms behind his back. I ordered the defendant to lay prone onto his face. The defendant continued to struggle with officers. At this time I placed my left forearm/elbow on the right side of the defendant's head and held it down toward the ground, while simultaneously attempting to pull the defendant's right arm from underneath him with my right arm.

Other officers then arrived and assisted with placing the defendant's arms behind his back, which were then secured into handcuffs. The defendant was then searched and placed into an awaiting patrol vehicle. During the search a small baggie of suspected cocaine was found on his person. Supervisors were notified of the incident and arrived on scene. The defendant claimed to officers that his head was in pain and wanted medical attention. The defendant was then transported to General Hospital by EMS, where he was later cleared and transported to booking.

On 06/14/2024, at approximately 0043 hours, I observed the altercation involving Mr. Driscoll and his friend outside Jason Aldean's, located at [REDACTED]. Mr. Driscoll was observed to have slapped his friend on at least two occasions and subsequently shoved him. I took immediate action to separate the individuals, as Mr. Driscoll displayed aggressive and confrontational behavior, in an effort to prevent further conflict, I physically intervened by pushing Mr. Driscoll away from the altercation. Despite my interventions, Mr. Driscoll remained belligerent.

I restrained Mr. Driscoll by holding his right arm with my both hands to guide him to the ground. With the help of officer Bergquist, Mr. Driscoll was brought to the ground. I used the necessary and reasonable amount of force to position his arm behind his back with both hands as Officer Bergquist secured his wrist's with handcuffs. Despite Mr. Driscoll's resistance, more officers arrived at the scene to assist in controlling Mr. Driscoll.

Use of Force

Supervisor Review

On 06/14/2024, at approximately 0043 hours, Ofc. Babbar and Ofc. Bergquist were conducting foot patrol in front of [REDACTED] (Jason Aldean's). Officers observed the defendant, Nathan Driscoll, and another individual in front of the business, both who appeared to be arguing with one another. Mr. Driscoll then grabbed the individual by his shirt and lifted the other individual's chin with his free hand. Officers observed Mr. Driscoll to then smack the individual in the face twice with an open. Officers then observed Mr. Driscoll wrestling with the other individual, which caused several rope barriers to be knocked over. Ofc. Bergquist and Babbar immediately ordered the individuals involved to stop and separate. Mr. Driscoll continued to fight with the other party refusing officers commands.

Ofc. Babbar and Bergquist went to take Mr. Driscoll into custody to separate the parties from fighting. Ofc. Babbar had to physically shove the defendant in the chest to separate the two individuals. Mr. Driscoll began yelling and cussing at officers stating that what he was doing was not wrong and that the other party was his friend. Mr. Driscoll was ordered by officers to place his hands behind his back in which he began to back up in an evasive manner refusing officers commands. Mr. Driscoll then attempted to run through officer Bergquist and Babbar to evade capture. Officer Bergquist and Babbar made the decision to take Mr. Driscoll to the ground to prevent Mr. Driscoll from continuing to evade/resist officers due to his lack of compliance.

Ofc. Adcox, Loose, and Maxwell were in the immediate vicinity during the incident and observed Ofc. Babbar and Bergquist to be struggling to take Mr. Driscoll into custody. Ofc. Adcox, Loose, and Maxwell assisted Ofc. Bergquist and Babbar place Mr. Driscoll into custody and into the backseat of a marked patrol vehicle. Mr. Driscoll claimed to officers that his head was in pain and wanted medical attention. The defendant was then transported to General Hospital by EMS before being taken to booking.

During my interview with Mr. Driscoll, Mr. Driscoll admitted to me on my BWC that he and some friends were in town from Miami when he confronted one of his friends that he was downtown with regarding his behavior towards a female. Mr. Driscoll stated that he did push his friend because they were involved in an argument. Mr. Driscoll stated that his friend did not want to prosecute him, and he was unsure of why the officers felt the need to intervene. Mr. Driscoll stated that he was pushed to the ground and put on his face after having previously had six surgeries on his face for a facial reconstruction surgery. When I asked Mr. Driscoll about his injuries from the officers that I would be able to observe tonight, Mr. Driscoll continued to speak of prior injuries from facial reconstruction surgeries, however, I was able to observe scuff marks on both temples of Mr. Driscoll's head that was consistent with injury that would have been caused by the sidewalk. I was also able to observe a scrape on the left knee of Mr. Driscoll that was consistent with a scrape from the sidewalk from the takedown officers had used on Mr. Driscoll. I also observed a minor scrape to the inside of Mr. Driscoll's right ankle. Mr. Driscoll was intoxicated when I spoke with him and was found to be in possession of a small amount of powder cocaine.

Conclusion of Fact


Ofc. Maxwell observed Ofc. Bergquist and Ofc. Babbar to be in a struggle with Mr. Driscoll while they were attempting to place Mr. Driscoll into custody regarding a fight they had observed. Ofc. Maxwell utilized his official presence, verbal commands, and soft empty-hand control to take a person engaged in fighting behavior, for whom there was probable cause to arrest, into custody. Ofc. Maxwell used a reasonable amount of force that was necessary to overcome the subject's active resistance to take him into custody.

After Ofc. Bergquist had utilized soft empty-hand control and an escort takedown technique to take Mr. Driscoll to the ground. Mr. Driscoll exhibited active resistance and pulled his body away from Ofc. Bergquist and Babbar's grasp in attempts to prevent himself from being placed in handcuffs. A brief struggle ensued with Ofc. Bergquist, Ofc. Babbar, FTO Adcox, Ofc. Maxwell, and Ofc. Loose in attempts to place Mr. Driscoll into custody due to his level of intoxication, refusal to obey commands, and physical resistance. Ultimately, officers were able to gain control of Mr. Driscoll and place him into custody. Ofc. Maxwell escalated and de-escalated his force appropriately throughout the incident.

After reviewing the above statements provided by Ofc. Maxwell and other officers involved in the incident, as well as all BWC/ICC video associated with this incident, I find that Ofc. Maxwell's use of force was consistent with and followed the current policy outlined in the Department Manual 11.10, Use of Force. The force used was reasonable and necessary and, therefore, justified.

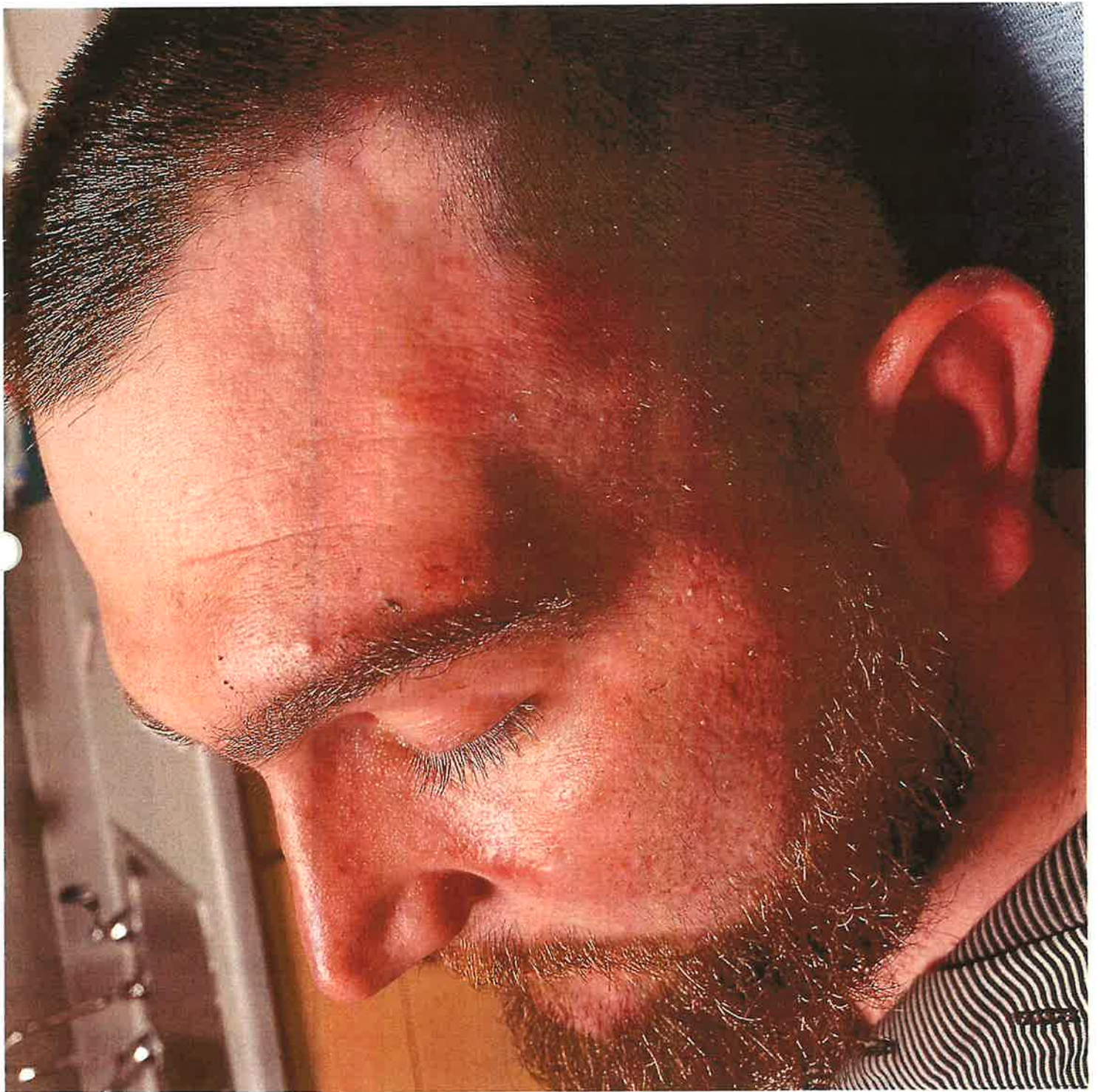

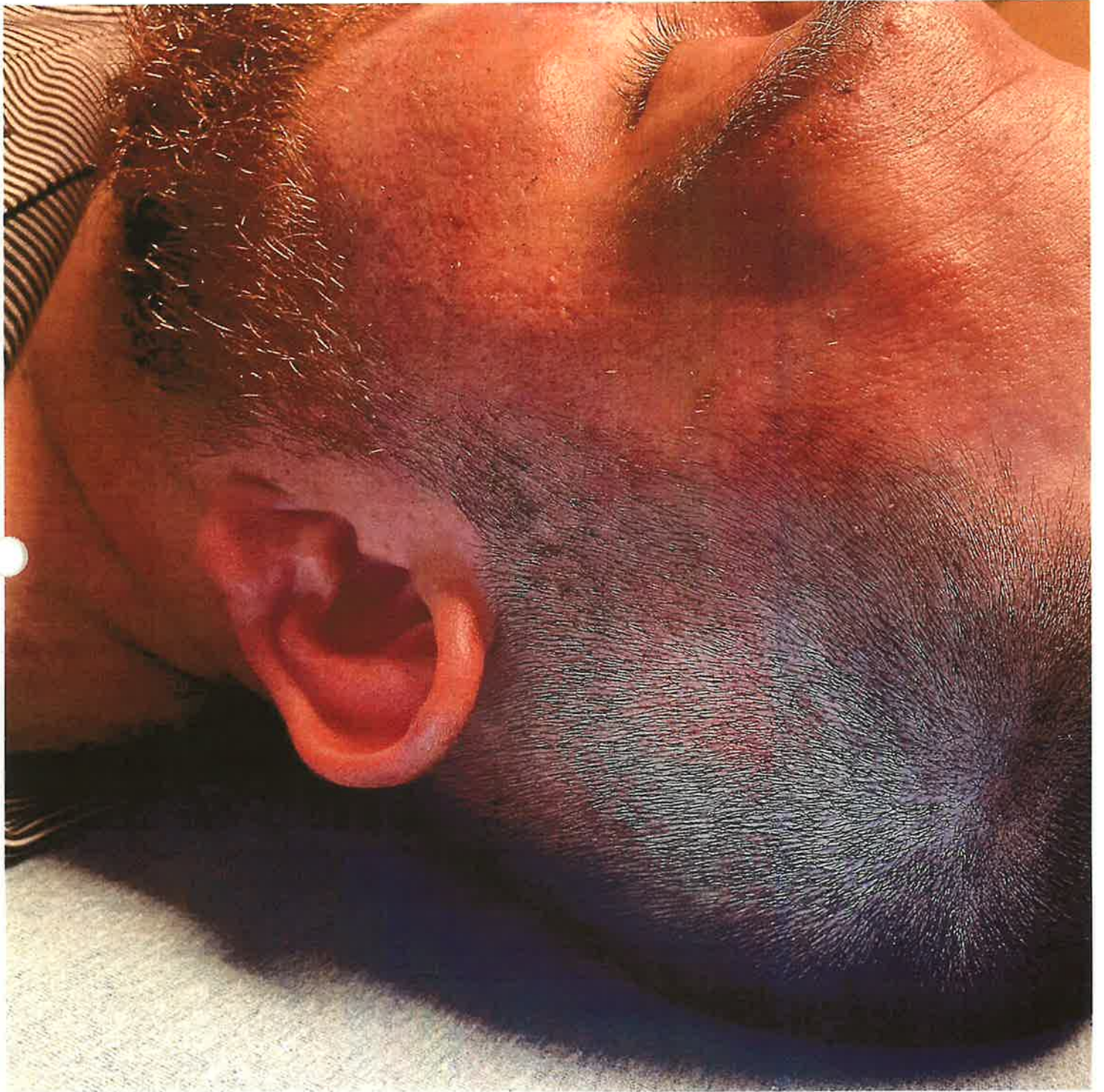

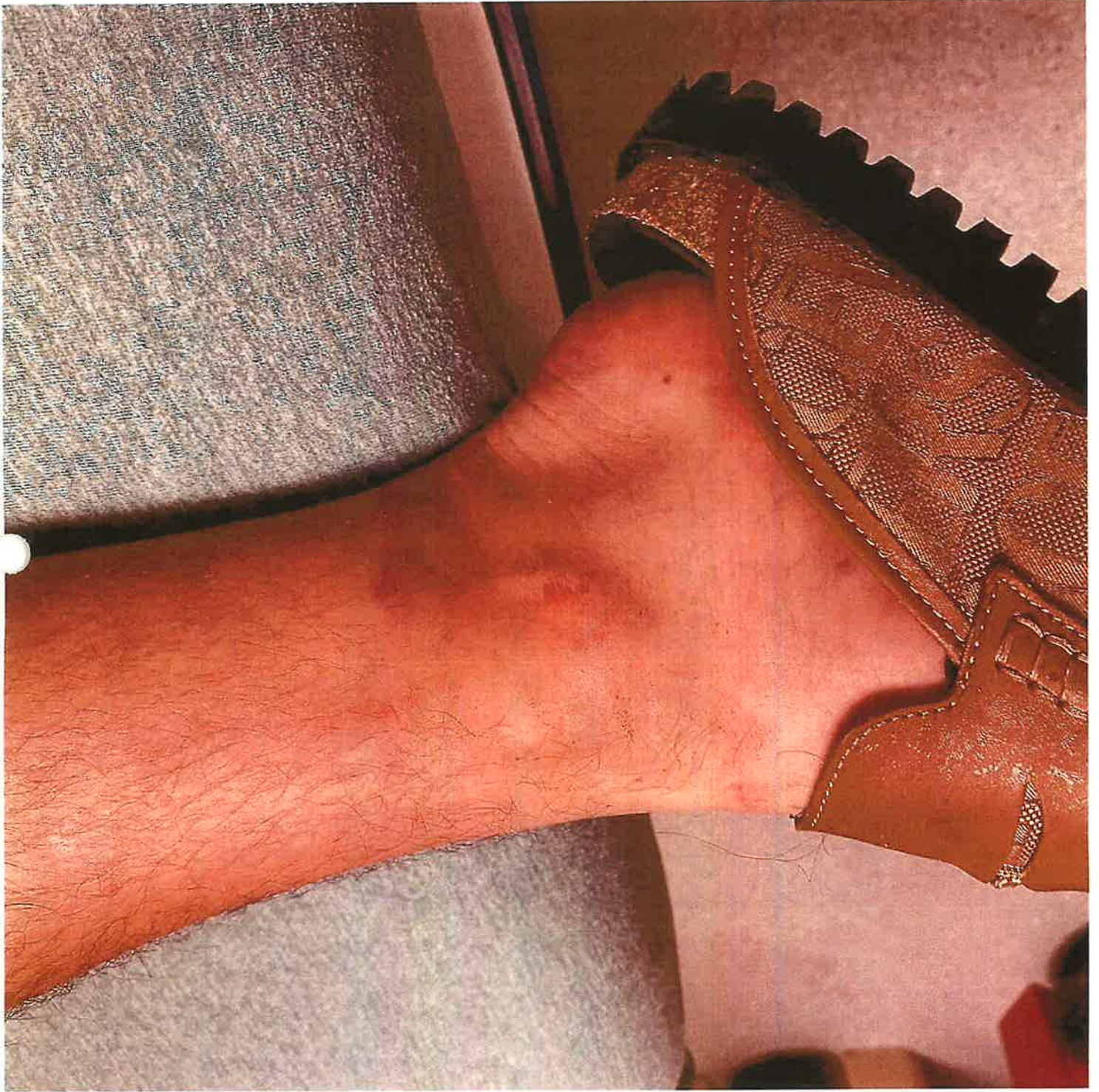
