Thank you for the thorough and complete Investigative Report regarding this incident. I do not believe any further investigation is necessary as you have included every detail of what occurred on November 7, 2025 that resulted in the death of Bradley Shane Tarnor.

After reviewing the Investigative Report it is the opinion of this office that the shooting death of Bradley Shane Tarnor was reasonably necessary under all the facts and circumstances and therefore a justifiable homicide. The evidence is very clear that Mr. Tarnor, despite repeated commands from the officers, continued to be a threat to the officers, and potentially others in proximity to the incident, until the threat was ended by the only force that was reasonable under the circumstances.

Based upon all the information regarding the matter I respectfully request the TBI close this matter. Any and all evidence collected and/or in the possession of the TBI may be disposed of in accordance with your policy and procedure. Please let me know if you have any questions.
