On June 27th at approximately 0440 hours, I responded to [REDACTED] regarding an officer involved shooting. Upon arrival, I met with Sgt Crissman who had established command at the scene. Sgt. Crissman and I briefly discussed the incident and the notifications being made, along with the crime scene location. I also met with Officers Scull, Mincer, and Poulos to check on their wellbeing, however I did not discuss any details of the incident with them. I advised Sgt. Crissman to obtain all three officers department issued phones so they could not review the incident on the Smart Control app. I then proceeded to the crime scene area to evaluate if any assistance was needed and to observe how the scene was being managed. I made the determination to apply additional crime scene tape to widen the area around the scene due to the incident being locate inside an apartment complex where a high volume of foot traffic may occur. I never entered the area where the deceased individual remained, nor did I observe his body.

At approximately 0530 hours, I proceeded to an adjacent apartment building in the direction where the shots were fired towards. I did not observe and damage to the exterior of the building which would be consistent with rounds entering the structure. Although I did not observe any damage, I reactivated my BWC and began knocking on the residents' doors. I knocked on doors [REDACTED], [REDACTED], [REDACTED], [REDACTED] and [REDACTED]. I was only able to make contact with the occupants in [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] which all advised they were safe and not injured.

During the remainder of my time on the scene, I maintained contact with Officers Scull, Mincer, and Poulos by their vehicles and did not approach the crime scene again. I came in contact with numerous personnel and directed them to the location of the scene and command. I did not obtain any details pertaining to the incident from the officers, only assisted them with questions and evaluated their mental status after a critical incident. Once my relief responded to the scene, I left the location and proceeded to West Precinct to upload my BWC/ICC. This ended my involvement with the incident.





<p>On 4/27/2024 at approximately 0410hrs, West Dispatch aired a 10-51P at [REDACTED] I was working CRI at the time, and was stopped at 481 Old Hickory Blvd (Mapco); which is adjacent to the apartment complex. I advised dispatch to show me, on scene in the area and waited for another unit to arrive; before proceeding further into the apartment complex. As we, proceeded further into the apartment complex, I requested descriptions of the involved parties. As we pulled past the leasing office we located the Victim/Complainant (David Van Sickle). He had a laceration to his right arm, and left hand. I then requested EMS to come to my location as they were staged down the road. As additional officers arrived, we gathered more information about the Suspect (Max Van Sickle). I sent Officers Poulos, Mincer and Scull up the hill to the apartment to locate the suspect based on this updated information. Officers began their search for the apartment, and I reconfirmed the apartment number of [REDACTED] with my victim. A short time later; I heard several gunshots coming from the vicinity of the apartment, and redirected the ambulance to where Officers Poulos, Mincer, and Scull were. Officers advised dispatch that shots were fired, and the Suspect was down.</p> <p>C-Detail supervisors arrived on scene, and established Command. I remained with the victim (David) until relieved by Ofc. Cara Allen. The victim (David) was transported to General Hospital by Medic 7 and Ofc. Allen followed. Command then directed me to head to 481 Old Hickory to manage the staging area and the media area. This staging area was later setup in front of the leasing office. While on scene, investigative elements began to show up, and all of the involved officers were relieved and separated near my location. I checked on the involved officers, and each of them appeared to be doing well given the circumstances. Officer Meskers was initially the scribe for the crime scene log, but I relieved him of those duties at approximately 0530hrs. As additional relief cars from out of sector arrived, I was relieved by Ofc. Hemingway (Hermitage C) at 0647hrs.</p> <p>I remained on scene to speak with investigators, and FOP representatives based on being involved in the incident. During this time, I downloaded by BWC/ICC footage to the server, and was released. I departed the location at 0820, and headed to West Precinct; to confirm that my BWC/ICC had downloaded, as it was indicating that it hadn't started. I then cleared off Code 6 with dispatch at 0855hrs, and headed home.</p>

<p>On 06/27/2024 at 0416 hours, I responded to a domestic related stabbing call for service at [REDACTED] While en route to the call, Sergeant Hunnicutt advised that he was out with the victim who had sustained lacerations to his arms. I arrived in the complex and Sergeant Hunnicutt said that the suspect may be on foot in the woods on Mountain Valley Dr. I canvased Mountain Valley Dr and then heard over the radio that shots were fired and that the suspect was down.</p> <p>I turned around and went to the building where the call for service originated. I exited my car and Officer Scully yelled to me for a medical bag. I retrieved my medical bag and ran up to the building and proceeded up the stairs towards unit [REDACTED] In the breezeway I saw the suspect laying face down and handcuffed. Officer George Poulos rolled the suspect on his back to evaluate his injuries. I saw that a tourniquet had already been applied to his left leg. I notified dispatch that I saw two gun shot wounds to the suspect's abdomen and what appeared to be a gun shot wound to his head.</p> <p>At this time Officer Benjamin Mincer asked for another officer to clear the apartment which was directly above us. I left my medical supplies with Officer Poulos and Officer Jonathan Scull. Officer Mincer, Officer Cara Allen, and I performed a protective sweep of the apartment and it was clear.</p> <p>I returned to the scene. I learned that Officer Scull was the officer involved with the shooting. I checked on Officer Scull and escorted him to his patrol vehicle. I established a perimeter and set up crime scene tape with Sergeant Michael Hunnicutt. I began a crime scene log of all people entering the crime scene.</p> <p>Sergeant David Crisman requested that I relieve Officer Poulos, who had still at the scene. I handed my crime scene log to Sergeant Hunnicutt. I then preserved the integrity of the crime scene until I was relieved by Officer Tony Folad at approximately 0715 hours.</p> <p>The following pages attached is the crime scene log:</p>

On 6/27/2024 I responded to a domestic cutting at the Bellevue Apartments off of Old Hickory Blvd. I was at the top of the complex with Officer Meskers looking in the woodline for the suspect. At this time Officer Mincer put out over the radio shots fired. Officer Meskers and I went to the apartment where the other officers were. Officer Scull met myself and Officer Meskers at the vehicles to grab a medical bag. I grabbed my medical bag and followed Officer Scull to the scene. When I arrived on scene, Officer Poulos was administering first aid to the suspect. I left my medical bag down with the suspect and went to apartment [REDACTED] with Meskers and Mincer to perform a sweep of the apartment. We cleared the apartment and returned to the scene. We located holes in the wall of the breezeway and knocked on the doors of the surrounding apartments to conduct welfare checks. We made contact with all residence in that area. Officer Poulos located a second knife at the scene, I secured the knife while NFD came to attend to the suspect. I was then sent down to Sgt. Hunnicutt to be with the victim. I followed NFD to Nashville General Hospital with the victim and stayed with him until a Domestic Violence Detective arrived to interview him. I then transported the victim to Police Headquarters to be interviewed by Cold Case, this was my last interaction with the victim.



While I was pulling into the apartment complex Officers on scene advised, over the radio, that "shots were fired" and "suspect is down." I immediately drove directly toward the apartment building to assist the Officers. When I arrived I observed Officers Scull, Poulos, and Mincer rendering aid and applying tourniquets to the suspect (Maxwell Van Sickle). Officer Meskers arrived on scene shortly after I did and assisted with rendering aid while I directed NFD Medics to the location. While on scene I observed a knife laying on the ground near the stairs leading to the floor below. I also observed a second knife on a walkway leading away from the apartments. After Medics declared time of death I instructed the Officers to check with all neighboring apartments to verify that all residents were safe and that no bullets went into their residence. I directed Officer Robish to put up crime scene tape and secure the scene. I also worked on positioning Officers along the perimeter of the scene to stop any pedestrian traffic. Officer Scull was separated from the scene and moved to his vehicle to wait for investigative units. I spoke with Officer Poulos concerning the incident to verify who discharged their weapon. Officer Poulos advised me that Officer Scull was the only Officer who fired at the suspect during the incident. I did not question any of the involved Officers any further concerning the incident. I directed Officer Allen to meet with the victim of the domestic violence incident, and to remain with them if they were transported to the hospital. Officer Allen followed the ambulance to General Hospital and remained with the victim (David Van Sickle) while he was questioned.</p> <p>While on scene I established command and began to assist with making advisements to Command Staff and all other Units concerning the incident. With the assistance of Sgt. Hunnicutt we established the staging area at the leasing office near the apartment building. As more personnel arrived they were directed to respond to the parking lot at the top of the hill where the main command location was established. I assisted BWC unit with obtaining the body worn cameras of Officers Scull, Mincer, and Poulos, and instructed them to terminate their vehicle recordings to allow them to upload. I also verified that Domestic Violence Detectives were advised of the incident, and advised them that the victim was transported to General Hospital. I continued to work on advising all necessary units and direct them to the scene. While on scene I assisted all patrol officers with helping any residents take their cars from inside the perimeter of the scene. Due, to the incident not occurring inside the parking lot we did not require any vehicles to remain within the perimeter. I remained at the scene of the command until I was relieved by Sgt.
