On June 27, 2024, at approximately 6:30 AM, Tennessee Bureau of Investigation (TBI) Special Agent (SA) Steven Kennard made contact with JONATHAN SCULL and informed him that TBI personnel would be requesting an interview with him in reference to the officer-involved shooting and asked if he had been in contact with any legal representation. SCULL advised he had contacted his FOP representative, and that he or she was on their way. SA Kennard informed SCULL he would come speak with him once his representation arrived. SA Kennard also made contact with the two assisting officers present during the shooting, Officer Polous and Officer Mincer, and informed both of request for an interview. Both officers advised they had representation in route as well.

At approximately 7:30 AM, SA Kennard again made contact with SCULL who was now with his attorney, John Brown. SA Kennard made the request to SCULL for an interview on this date in which SCULL advised he would prefer to wait a few days before interviewing, but that he would interview. A tentative date of Monday, July 1, 2024 was set for the interview. SA Kennard spoke next with attorney Kristin Berexa who advised that she had already spoken with Officers Poulos and Mincer, and they would also be waiting until Monday to participate in an interview.

SA Kennard passed this information on to case agent, Matthew Massingill.

On July 10, 2024, TBI Special Agent (SA) Matthew Massingill was contacted by SA Andrew Graves. SA Graves informed SA Massingill that SA Graves had just spoken with Metro Nashville Police Department (MNPDP) Detective (DT) Jeff Gibson. SA Graves told SA Massingill that DT Gibson had requested audio in an investigation that SA Graves has been working on and asked if SA Massingill had completed interviews in this investigation.

SA Massingill contacted DT Gibson and informed him that SA Massingill had completed interviews with Officers JONATHAN SCULL, George Poulos, and Benjamin Mincer. DT Gibson asked if SA Massingill could provide a copy of those interviews to MNPDP DT Amanda Topping. SA Massingill told DT Gibson that he would speak with supervision and get back to him.

On July 11, 2024, SA Graves informed SA Massingill that he had spoken with Special Agent in Charge (SA) Josh Savley and was given permission to release the interviews in both investigations. SA Graves told SA Massingill that he was going to meet with DT Gibson and would be willing to take a copy of SA Massingill's interviews with him. SA Massingill placed all three audio-recorded interviews onto SA Graves's USB storage device and released the interviews to DT Gibson.

A property release form and a TBI OIS Release Case File Memo A form were completed. A copy of both forms will be serialized separately from this investigative report.




Around this time officers were dispatched to a call for service at Ridge Lake Apartments in Bellevue (123z) involving a subject with a knife that had stabbed his brother. Sgt. Hunnicutt who was working a crime reduction initiative also responded to the scene followed by Sgt. Crisman (120C) who was in route. Around 0423hrs, Ofc. Scull advised over the radio " shots fired." Additional information came across the radio related to medical treatment and NFD medics requested to assist.</p> <p>Sgt. Turner responded to the scene, and I stayed at the precinct and made phone notification to acting commander Lt. Nave once I knew the condition of the officers and suspect. I had dispatch send out the MEANS page to notify additional resources, then I followed up by sending a FSS email. I had additional phone conversations with Chief Hager, Cmndr. Kendall and Don Aaron about the incident.</p> <p>I never responded to the scene of the shooting. I began coordinated calls for service with dispatch and requested additional recourses the scene of the OIS.</p>

<p>On June 27, 2024, at approximately 0430 hours, I received a phone call from Sgt. John Tuberville letting me know there was an officer involved shooting in West Precinct. He did not have many details at that time, as it had only been a couple of minutes. I was acting Commander while Commander Kendall was on military leave. I called Commander Kendall, then Inspector Wheeler and gave them the address of the incident. I then called Department of Emergency Communications and made sure a MEANS notification was being sent out as well.</p> <p>After I got ready, I drove to the scene and assumed the roll of Precinct Commander, when I stopped my BWC/ICC. I made sure Sgt. David Crisman, command for the incident, had what he needed to secure the scene, relieve involved officers from posts, and prepare for shift change. I also spoke with various command staff and investigators to ensure everything involving the incident and investigation was being handled correctly.</p> <p>After TBI released the scene and Domestic Violence Detectives completed a search of the apartment, I assisted in taking down the crime scene tape before leaving the location.</p>




On 06/27/2024 around 05:00hrs I was notified by Capt. Bill Watkins and Inspector Rita Baker of an officer involved shooting incident [REDACTED] (later determined to be [REDACTED]) in West Precinct. I contacted Sgt. David Crisman to get a brief of the situation for proper response and he informed me patrol responded to the above domestic related altercation between brothers involving a knife. When officers responded they spoke with brother victim, later identified as David Van Sickle, who had explained to them his brother was having a episode and attempted to stab him and attack him with a knife. He pointed out where the apartment was and West Patrol officers went to locate the other brother, later identified as Maxwell Van Sickle. When Officer Jonathan Scull and two other patrol officers, later identified as George Poulos and Benjamin Mincer went to locate Maxwell, he ran down the steps towards them wielding a knife. Commands were given to drop the knife, but he did not and Officer Jonathan Scull fired at him. Maxwell was deceased at the scene. I then contacted Det. Mike Roland to respond to the scene. I also responded to the scene. I contacted Josh Savely from the TBI and David Zoccola from the District Attorney's office. They were already aware of the situation from Deputy Chief Hagar and had people in route.

When I arrived on the scene, I pulled into the lower parking lot of Spring Creek Dr. near the pond area. Det. Mike Roland was present and gathering information along with SA Steven Kinnard from the TBI. I spoke with Sgt. Brad Turner, Sgt. Chrisman and Lt. Brad Nave from West Precinct to solidify the briefing I received earlier. Officers Scull, Poulos, Mincer and Sgt. Hunnicut were all part of the incident and were standing by to speak with their FOP attorney and receive further instruction from the TBI. David Van Sickle had been transported to Meharry General for medical treatment for his wounds from the incident. I coordinated with Domestic Violence for a response at Meharry and to the scene for the domestic aspect of this incident. I contacted DEC for the call text and exact name of phone number of the person who called in which was David Van Sickle. I also wanted to verify the appropriate address with them on the scene. I coordinated information sharing and assistance to TBI agent Matthew Massingill who was going to be the lead on this OIS for the TBI. I did observe the scene and saw multiple 9mm shell casings going towards the breezeway area of the 2nd floor where Maxwell Van Sickle had come down the stairs to accost the responding officers. I also observed a large silver butcher knife and the handle of another knife by the staircase. I also observed a red medic bag left by NFD personnel who was rendering aid next to the decedent.

I continued to update command personnel during my presence. While the scene was being processed, I was informed David Van Sickle had been released from the hospital. Patrol Officer Allen was instructed to transport him to Police HQ at 600 Murfreesboro for an interview with the

TBI. Det. Andrew Davis assisted with getting an interview room together. I then went to the leasing office to obtain a copy of the lease agreement for agent Massingill. The lease was only in Maxwell's name. Det. Roland continued assisting the TBI along with DV Detective Pinho. Once TBI completed processing the OIS portion in the breezeway, DV Detective Pinho and Sgt. Door executed a search warrant on the apartment for photographs and collection of any other evidence pertinent to the DV portion of this incident. Once that was completed, I contacted the leasing office again to secure the apartment. I did review the BWC of all officers involved later in the office. This completes my involvement in this case.


