This investigation was predicated on November 12, 2022, upon the request of Glen Funk, District Attorney General for the Twentieth Judicial District, State of Tennessee. The scope of this investigation is to ascertain the facts and circumstances surrounding an officer-involved shooting in Madison, TN located in Davidson County.

On November 12th, 2022, SA Chris Houk received a phone call from ASAC Rielly Gray that there had been an officer involved shooting at 201 Gallatin Pike located in Davidson County. On November 12th, 2022, Sgt. SPADAVECCHIA, Sgt. TIMM, and Ofc ROBISH responded to a call for service where an individual had been shot. While these LE officers were working this scene SENQUARIUS WILLIAMS began walking towards the crime scene. Sgt. TIMM asked WILLIAMS to take his hands out of his pockets and WILLIAMS was approaching the crime scene tape. WILLIAMS walked under the crime scene tape, produced a firearm and started firing at Sgt. TIMM. Sgt. TIMM, Sgt. SPADAVECCHIA, and Ofc. ROBISH all returned fire striking WILLIAMS multiple times. WILLIAMS was pronounced deceased at the scene.

On November 13, 2022, at approximately 8:00 AM, TBI Special Agent (S/A) Taylor Looney arrived at the Davidson County Medical Examiner's Office and met with S/A Chris Houk and Death Investigator Melanie Byrd. The purpose was to utilize the portable Morpho Ident machine to identify the deceased individual involved in this case. After the fingerprint scans were obtained, S/A Looney proceeded back to TBI Headquarters, where the prints were run through the Tennessee Automated Fingerprint Identifications System (AFIS.) A positive hit was received, identifying the deceased man as SENQUARIUS WILLIAMS.

On 11/12/2022 at 10am, JEREMY D. BROWN, was interviewed by the reporting agent at the Vanderbilt University Medical Center Emergency Room – 1211 Medical Center Drive, Nashville, TN, 37232 in relation to an officer involved shooting incident (JEREMY D. BROWN had been shot prior to the officer involved shooting). After proper identification and explanation of the purpose for the interview, Mr. BROWN voluntarily provided an audio recorded statement. The recording has been saved and is in the custody of SA Moseley and will be released to the District Attorney's Office upon request. The following is a brief synopsis of the audio interview:

Mr. BROWN was reluctant to answer most questions. He would not provide a description of the subject who shot him and would not describe the gun the suspect used to shoot him.

The reporting agent interviewed Mr. BROWN with Metro Nashville Police Department Detective Lukas Cantrell, who were able to piece together the following information from the interview with Mr. BROWN.

Mr. BROWN stated that he does not live in the area where he was shot. He stated that he rode a bus to that location and was hanging out in the area for 1-2 hours before he was shot. He stated that he was sitting in a vehicle with a "white, Italian" female named Joann. He stated Ms. Joann told him to get out of the vehicle when multiple people approached the area. Mr. BROWN stated that he got out of the vehicle when a suspect shot him multiple times. Mr. BROWN told the reporting agent multiple times to speak with Ms. Joann. The interview ended at 10:23am.

SA Moseley also assisted in this case by responding to the scene of the shooting on 11/12/2022 at 4:15am for an information briefing from Metro Nashville Police Department (MNPd) Lt. Brent Gibson. SA Moseley then met with MNPd Lt. Sam Tetterton at MNPd Headquarters on 11/12/2022 at 7:15am to view body camera and patrol car video camera footage, and facilitated the release of this video footage to TBI SA Chris Houk.

On November 12th, 2022 at approximately 3:28 AM, Tennessee Bureau of Investigation (TBI) Special Agent (SA) Kendall Henderson received a call from Assistant Special Agent in Charge (ASAC) Rielly Gray requesting assistance on the scene of an officer-involved shooting. ASAC Gray advised a male subject had been shot by Metropolitan-Nashville Police Department (MNP) officers and the subject was deceased. ASAC Gray advised SA Henderson that additional Agents would be called in to assist in processing the scene.

SA Henderson arrived at 201 Gallatin Pike in Nashville, Tennessee at approximately 4:09 AM. The temperature was in the high 30s and it was steadily raining. The scene was located at the intersection of Maple Street and Brawner Avenue approximately one block from Gallatin Pike. The above-mentioned address is the location of the Madison Family Restaurant located at the corner of a strip-mall center. A perimeter of crime scene tape stretched from the southwest corner of the Aldi grocery store, located across the street at the corner of Gallatin Pike and Maple Street, to the northeast corner of the Madison Family Restaurant located at the above-mentioned address. Additional crime scene tape was placed from the southeast corner of the Aldi to a telephone pole across Maple Street at the back corner of what appeared to be a car lot. A marked MNP patrol unit sat at the corner of Hickory Street and Brawner Avenue. Additional crime scene tape was placed on a telephone pole at the corner of Maple Street and Brawner Avenue, connecting to a car parked in the car lot. This tape also extended back to the northeast corner of the Madison Family Restaurant, creating a perimeter around the entire T-intersection of Maple Street and Brawner Avenue.

Around 4:30 AM, SA Henderson, SA Scarbro, and SAFI Moseley were briefed by MNP Cold Case Lieutenant Pat Taylor and Homicide Lieutenant Gibson. The preliminary information indicated that MNP officers had been dispatched to a shooting at the above-mentioned address earlier in the night. Officers secured the scene and were in the process of notifying crime scene and investigations personnel when the subject entered the crime scene tape unannounced and fired shots at officers on scene. Three officers returned fire including Sergeant LEONARD SPADAVECCHIA, Sergeant JOHN TIMM, and Officer JOHN ROBISH. Goodlettsville officers had previously been requested for assistance with manpower for the original shooting scene but arrived shortly after the officer-involved shooting took place. Due to the original shooting scene and the officer-involved shooting scene being intertwined, it was

determined that TBI Agents would be collecting all items of evidence.

The victim was lying near the middle of Maple Street where Brawner Avenue connects. The victim was lying face up with his hands tucked underneath his back. It appeared that the victim's shirt and jacket had been cut, possibly by Medics when aid was rendered. Further west on Maple Street near a marked MNPd patrol car was a pink and black Kel-Tec pistol. Cartridge casings were located in clusters around the crime scene. Six .40 caliber casings were located on the sidewalk off the southwest corner of Aldi. One .380 caliber casing was located further east in the roadway past Brawner Avenue. Three .380 caliber casings and one .40 caliber casing were located near the EMS Chief's vehicle parked in the corner of the car lot at the intersection. Four .380 caliber casings were found near the telephone pole off the northeast corner of the Madison Family Restaurant in the roadway. Two .40 caliber casings were located in between two marked MNPd patrol cars that were parked on the north side of the Madison Family Restaurant.

SA Henderson photographed the three involved officers at approximately 4:48 AM. After the officers were photographed Agents collected the officers' duty weapons. SA Houk took possession of Sergeant SPADAVECCHIA and Sergeant TIMM's duty weapons and SA Henderson took possession of Officer ROBISH's duty weapon. Property receipts were completed to document this transaction. SA Henderson temporarily secured the weapons in her vehicle for the remainder of processing the crime scene. At approximately 5:22 AM, SA Henderson began taking overall photographs of the scene. Additional photographs were taken to demonstrate the relationship of items of evidence to the scene and document the characteristics of items of evidence.

All items determined to be evidence were marked with yellow evidence placards and photographed by SA Henderson. MNPd Crime Scene Investigator Danielle Connor and SA Henderson worked together to photograph the scene to ensure MNPd had the photographs of evidence needed to document the original shooting scene.

ASAC Gray and SA Scarbro took measurements of items of evidence. ASAC Gray will complete a crime scene diagram which will be serialized separately within the case file. Measurements are as follows:

Each item was measured and documented by ASAC Gray and SA Scarbro prior to collection by SA Houk. A projectile from the hospital was transported to the scene by MNPD Officer/Crime Scene Investigator Justin Cregan and was transferred to SA Scarbro. After evidence collection was completed, Medical Examiner's Office Investigator Lauren Fisher performed an exam of the body. Two socks were located in the back-right pocket of the victim's pants. In the victim's front left pocket, a flip-style cell phone was located. The cell phone was removed from the pocket at approximately 8:48 AM and transferred to SA Houk. A cursory exam of the body provided that there were several gunshot wounds to the victim's chest and below his right shoulder blade. After the exam, the victim was placed into a body bag which was labeled "MEC #22-4281 Unidentified Male" and transported to the Medical Examiner's Office.

SA Henderson transferred the officers' duty weapons to SA Scarbro prior to departing the scene at approximately 9:26 AM.

SA Scarbro transported all items of evidence to TBI Headquarters. Items of evidence were secured in the temporary storage section of the Middle Criminal Investigation Division (CID) Office at approximately 11:30 AM. Evidence remained secured in the office until it was submitted to the TBI Evidence Management Unit by SA Houk the following business day, November 14th, 2022.

Property receipts documenting the transfer of evidence will be serialized separately within the case file. 304 photographs were taken by SA Henderson in total and will be maintained in the working case file.

On November 15th, 2022 at approximately 10:02 AM, Tennessee Bureau of Investigation (TBI) Special Agent (SA) Kendall Henderson interviewed Metropolitan-Nashville Police Officer (MNP) Officer LEONARD SPADAVECCHIA at TBI Headquarters located at 901 R.S. Gass Boulevard in Nashville, Tennessee. The interview was audio recorded and a copy will be provided to the District Attorney's Office upon request. After proper identification and explanation of the purpose of the interview, SPADAVECCHIA voluntarily provided an audio recording. The following is a synopsis of that interview:

He has not reviewed any video of the incident with the exception of the three-minute press release video Don Aaron released. He has not discussed the incident with any other officers or witnesses. SPADAVECCHIA began his career in law enforcement with MNP 2014 but graduated from the police academy in 2015. [REDACTED]

He was on duty prior to this incident. A call for service in relation to a shooting was dispatched. Madison patrol was short staffed, and the other officers were responding to other calls. Since no other officers were available, Sergeant TIMM and Sergeant SPADAVECCHIA responded. TIMM is the 10s district Sergeant and SPADAVECCHIA is an extra sergeant but due to a manpower shortage SPADAVECCHIA was serving as the 20s district Sergeant that night. On his way to the call, SPADAVECCHIA realized he did not have crime scene tape. Sergeant TIMM advised him to return to Madison precinct and bring tape back. He responded to the scene in uniform and in a marked vehicle. The vehicle's lights were activated but the sirens were turned off prior to arriving on scene. The initial information indicated someone had been shot behind the Madison Family Restaurant. The information dispatch was receiving from the complainants was convoluted and they weren't quite clear on exactly what happened. Once he arrived on scene, the shooting victim was already loaded into the ambulance. Due to the conflicting information being received, Sergeant TIMM advised there may be other victims nearby. They created a perimeter of crime scene tape and swept the area for additional victims. Officer ROBISH arrived while they were sweeping the area and finished taping off the scene. All three officers arrived

separately. They began notifying CSI and investigations personnel and were finishing interviewing witnesses.

A witness asked Sergeant SPADAVECCHIA to get his belongings out of a shopping cart nearby. SPADAVECCHIA walked to his patrol car to retrieve a pair of gloves prior to conducting a brief search of the man's belongings. His patrol car was parked near the car lot at the intersection of Brawner Avenue and Maple Street. He began talking to the EMS District Chief. Once he turned around from retrieving a pair of gloves, an unknown male-black had already entered the crime scene and was approaching Sergeant TIMM with an outstretched arm holding a gun. Before SPADAVECCHIA processed that the subject had a gun, the subject began shooting in the direction of Sergeant TIMM. It was clear to him that the subject's intent was to kill Sergeant TIMM. He drew his pistol and fired one shot.

SPADAVECCHIA constructed a diagram displaying the officers' approximate positions during the incident.

The subject approached the officers moving north on Brawner Avenue. As the subject continued moving towards Sergeant TIMM, SPADAVECCHIA realized he did not have a proper back drop to fire any additional rounds. He moved around the vehicle to try and eliminate the risk of crossfire but at that point, the subject was no longer a threat. Officer ROBISH handcuffed the subject. When the subject originally approached, SPADAVECCHIA observed one individual in the proximity of the subject inside the crime scene tape. It was unclear if this individual arrived with the subject, but the individual ran towards Gallatin Pike when the shooting began. The individual was wearing a black hoodie with white writing or possibly a logo. He knew the individuals were within the crime scene tape, but he did not see how if they were dropped off from a vehicle or arrived on foot. He does not remember the subject saying anything when he approached. He looked up and saw the subject with an outstretched arm holding a gun. Sergeant TIMM and Officer ROBISH began yelling but SPADAVECCHIA could not recall what commands were being given. He did observe the subject fire shots towards Sergeant TIMM to which it became clear to SPADAVECCHIA that the subject was trying to kill him.

Once he moved around the vehicle, he realized the subject was no longer a threat. While Officer ROBISH was handcuffing the subject, SPADAVECCHIA provided cover in case there were additional suspects in the area. SPADAVECCHIA recalled seeing the muzzle flash from the subject's firearm. He believed the firearm to be small and possibly a color other than black. The subject fired two to three shots, but he did not know how many shots the other officers fired. He did not consider any other use of force options due to the situation escalating very quickly. The threat present was not only to officers and the EMS District Chief but to two civilian witnesses who were in the grass area beside the Aldi grocery store. No other use of force would have been effective given the circumstances. The subject was no longer considered a threat once he was handcuffed.

The EMS District Chief provided medical attention and advised officers that the subject was not likely to survive. Goodlettsville officers arrived shortly after the shooting, but they were originally requested to assist with manpower from the original shooting incident. MNPD officers advised the Goodlettsville officer to retrieve a rifle. The officers held cover in the area before rendering aid due to the potential for additional threats. Dispatch was notified on the radio that additional units were needed. SPADAVECCHIA did not provide medical attention. No one else was injured during the shooting. The officer's checked each other for injuries and swept the area for

potential threats again. SPADAVECCHIA did observe a pistol on the ground near the subject after the shooting but could not estimate the distance.

The interview was concluded at 10:32 AM. The sketch SPADAVECCHIA provided will be serialized separately within the case file. The information above is meant to be a summary only and not intended to be an exact transcript of the interview. A digital copy of the above-mentioned interview will be maintained by the case agent in the working case file.

On November 12, 2022, at approximately 5:06 AM Special Agent (SA) James Scarbro and SA Chris Houk with the Tennessee Bureau of Investigation (TBI) interviewed JOHANNA FECAROTTA while sitting in the back of an ambulance in the parking lot of Aldi's located at 135 S. Gallatin Pike, Madison, Tennessee. After proper identification and an explanation for the purpose of the interview, FECAROTTA provided the following information. This interview was audio recorded and that recording will be kept in the case agents investigative working file and a copy given to the District Attorney's Office. Below is a brief synopsis of the audio interview and should not be considered a transcript:

FECAROTTA advised that she was sitting inside a car which was parked on the other side of Aldi's. She advised it was a rental car used for security. She noticed a couple of kids and thought they were stealing stuff, and she told a man she called "Main" that he should go check to see what the kids were doing. "Main" was a guy that was inside a truck watching like she was. FECAROTTA said "Main" actually got drunk and went to sleep in his truck. She said she sat in front of the blue car and was watching the kids and thought one of them had a shotgun. She said there were two kids, and one was a little Spanish kid and a mixed kid.

FECAROTTA said "JB" went to get her some tacos. She said "JB" is James Brown and is the person who was shot earlier. She said JB returned, and she looked over at the bus stop and saw the two boys. One was tall and one was short. She said all of a sudden she heard a gunshot where the two boys were standing. FECAROTTA said she then fell asleep for a little bit because she was full, but JB woke her up and told her to look. FECAROTTA said she saw that the boys had a purse which had a long strap. She said JB then told her to let him out of the car. The boys walked down the sidewalk and got to one of the poles, and the tall one walked over to the dumpster. FECAROTTA said the short one walked off the curb and walked to the bushes. She said then the tall one came out of nowhere and he came up faster and stood in the road near the sewer drain. FECAROTTA said she believed the guy was going to shoot her and JB, and that is when she yelled at JB to get out. She said JB got out and said, "What's going on?", and that's when the man started shooting JB. She said the other guy (in her car) ran off, and she jumped back into the car. FECAROTTA said she wasn't getting out of the car but saw the guy standing behind the silver furnace near a building and another guy handed him something and it was like the guy was loading a shotgun or something. She said the guy came back

across the street and opened the car door on her. FECAROTTA said the guy told her to get out, but she said no. She said she tried to talk to the guy to distract him, but the guy said what do I do. FECAROTTA said she told the guy to get out there, and the little one disappeared. She said the guy, was looking at her kind of crazy and telling her to get out. FECAROTTA said she told the man the police were coming, and the guy ran off. She said she tried to help JB and heard the sirens.

FECAROTTA said when the police arrived they asked her what happened, and she told them that the people were still around. FECAROTTA said there were two or three officers and were putting up crime scene tape. She said she heard dogs and she was standing in the middle of the sidewalk, and then she looked up and the tall guy, the little guy, and another one that went up the alley. She said the guy must have gone home and changed clothes. She said she saw the guy walking toward the officers and one guy had a gun with a red laser. Asked which one had the gun with a laser, and FECAROTTA said it was the little boy. She said he got away but were side by side when they were walking up to officers. She said it was like they were walking up to talk. FECAROTTA said she saw the guy walk toward the officers and started shooting at the police.

On November 12, 2022, at approximately 6:08 AM Special Agent (SA) James Scarbro and SA Chris Houk with the Tennessee Bureau of Investigation (TBI) interviewed MARQUIS CROWDER in the Aldi's parking lot located at 135 S. Gallatin Pike, Madison, Tennessee. After proper identification and an explanation for the purpose of the interview, CROWDER provided the following information. This interview was audio recorded and that recording will be kept in the case agents investigative working file and a copy given to the District Attorney's Office. Below is a brief synopsis of the audio interview and should not be considered a transcript:

CROWDER explained that he and a friend, named Marcellas had been out drinking. CROWDER said he is homeless but sleeps in a truck which is a gray Dodge Ram (located within the crime scene during this interview) owned by the car lot. CROWDER said he heard a bunch of gunshots, but he didn't see anything because he was asleep in the gray truck.

CROWDER said as he and Marcellus were coming back to his truck, and he noticed a Mexican guy sitting on the slab and had on an orange hoodie with painters' pants. He said the guy had a goat tee and was really skinny. He came from behind the Aldi's and was by himself. CROWDER said he and Marcellus get in the truck and go to sleep. CROWDER said he woke up and Marcellus was gone, so he got into the back seat and went back to sleep. He said about an hour later he heard a bunch of gunshots and heard Johanna yelling and screaming. CROWDER said he laid back down and went to sleep. CROWDER said he didn't wake up because he didn't think he heard the sirens.

CROWDER said he then heard some more guns shots and Metro yelling, "get on the ground", "don't do it" or something like that. CROWDER said he never saw anyone with a gun, or anyone shoot anyone because he was inside the truck. He heard things but didn't see anything. CROWDER said when you are homeless, if something is not your business, then you leave it alone. CROWDER said JB is another homeless person. He is the one who was shot.

On November 12, 2022, at approximately 5:36 AM Special Agent (SA) James Scarbro and SA Chris Houk with the Tennessee Bureau of Investigation (TBI) interviewed DONALD ALLEN while sitting in the back of an ambulance in the parking lot of Aldi's located at 135 S. Gallatin Pike, Madison, Tennessee. After proper identification and an explanation for the purpose of the interview, ALLEN provided the following information. This interview was audio recorded and that recording will be kept in the case agents investigative working file and a copy given to the District Attorney's Office. Below is a brief synopsis of the audio interview and should not be considered a transcript:

ALLEN is Metro Nashville Fire Department District Chief 38, D shift, and responded to the initial shooting on Maple Street in Madison. He drove the MNFD white Taurus with the red lights that was inside the crime scene tape. ALLEN advised that he received a call on the initial shooting report. He said he, the ambulance, and the engine company staged away from the scene. He was on the backside of Aldi's. He said when the first officer arrived, he went ahead and went into the scene because he could see the man lying on the ground and he called for the second medic unit. ALLEN advised the shooting victim had 6 ballistic injuries and he was awake and alert and talking. ALLEN said the officers were looking for the other guys who ran, and he was trying to secure the scene as best he could because there were not a lot of officers there. He identified cartridge casings and was trying to direct cars away from them. He said two people were walking through the scene and he was trying to get them to stand away. ALLEN said he heard the woman (he identified as Fecarotta) yell gun and he looked up and saw a man pointing a gun at the police officers. ALLEN said he hit the ground behind his car and heard between 6 and 9 shots. He said it was rapid fire so hard to tell, but he did remember hearing an officer yell "drop the gun" and "get on the ground". ALLEN said when he got up, he radioed shots fired and the police began rendering aid. He said he heard one of the officers say that the man was going to need a chest seal. ALLEN said one officer asked if he was ok, and then he went over to the person they shot, and he heard agonal respirations. ALLEN said the man the police shot had a handgun and it was pink. ALLEN said he did not see the direction the man came from.

ALLEN said he went to his car to get a monitor and returned but at this point another officer yelled "He's over here". ALLEN said he returned to his car and waited for the scene to be

declared clear but had already called for another medic to stand-by for the man who police shot. ALLEN said by the time he was able to get to the man, he had passed.

ALLEN explained that the first person shot (the reason for the initial call) was transported to Vanderbilt before the officer involved shooting. For further information, please refer to the complete audio recorded interview in the investigative case file.

On Monday, November 14, 2022, Special Agent (SA) Chris Houk of the Tennessee Bureau of Investigation requested that I, SA James Scarbro, assist him with an investigation pertaining to an officer involved shooting that occurred on Maple Street in vicinity of 201 Gallatin Pike, Madison, Tennessee on November 12, 2022. While processing the crime scene in the vicinity of 201 Gallatin Pike, agents recovered a cell phone in the possession of DEMONTA SENQUARIUS WILLIAMS. All evidence items were placed in temporary storage prior to submission to the CID vault or lab on November 12, and I collected the phone from that locker to perform the forensic analysis. I began the extraction of the telephone at approximately 9:53 AM November 14, 2022, and completed the extraction at approximately 10:09 AM the same day.

CUSTODY AND CONTROL

On Monday, November 14, 2022, I received the Alcatel cell phone from the CID temporary storage locker. The device was not password protected, and I had placed the phone in Airplane mode prior when packaged on November 12, 2022. I completed a logical extraction of the phone this same day and attempted to complete a physical extraction with no results. I returned the phone to SA Houk on November 14, 2022. A copy of the property receipt documenting chain of custody of the cell phone will be submitted to the electronic case file.

EXAMINATION OF MEDIA

A. Preservation of Original Media

I confirmed the device was in Airplane mode, Bluetooth disabled, and Wi-Fi disabled prior to forensic examination to prevent the phone from connecting to the cellular or Wi-Fi network. All data was extracted from the phone while in this setting.

B. Scope of Inquiry

The digital media was examined to identify any evidence of violations of the laws of the State of Tennessee.

C. Findings

The Cellebrite UFED software used to examine the evidence allows for the generation of a UFED Reader report. This report allows investigating personnel the ability to examine the readable data without modifying the original evidence. A UFED Reader report was generated and placed on a password protected external hard drive and transferred to a secure media location for examination by investigating personnel.



Statement of Facts, Remarks:

Metro Nashville SGT John Timm, SGT Leonard Spadavecchia, and Officer John Robish were working an unrelated shooting crime scene located at 201 Gallatin Pike in Nashville, TN when Senquarius Williams approached SGT Timm, pointed a pink Keltec pistol at him and began shooting at him. SGT Timm returned fire along with SGT Spadavecchia and Officer Robish. As a result of this use of force Senquarius Williams was pronounced deceased at the scene.

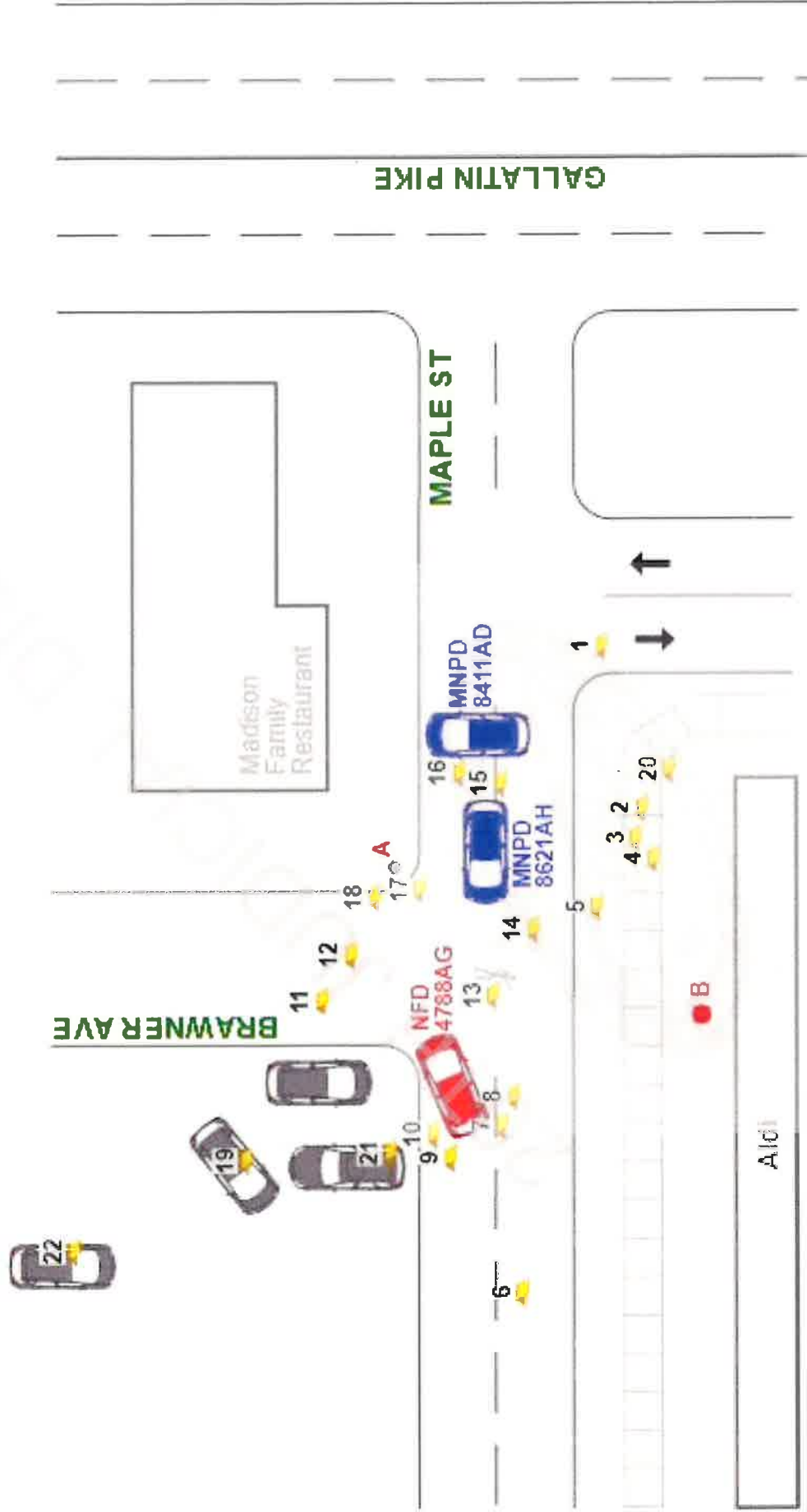

Thank you for meeting with Deputy District Attorney Amy Hunter, Deputy District Attorney Roger Moore and me about this incident. After reviewing your investigative file and discussing the matter with you, it is our opinion the shooting death of Senquarius Demonta Williams was beyond any doubt a case of justifiable homicide. The video footage, particularly the in-car camera video, establishes that the Metropolitan Nashville Police Officers who discharged their weapons did so after and while Senquarius Williams was shooting at them. Their actions were not only in justifiable self-defense of themselves but also were in defense of each other and in defense of one or more private citizens whose lives were placed in jeopardy by Senquarius Williams.

Therefore, based on the facts as they are known to exist, I request the TBI close the above referenced case. Please let me know if you have any questions.
